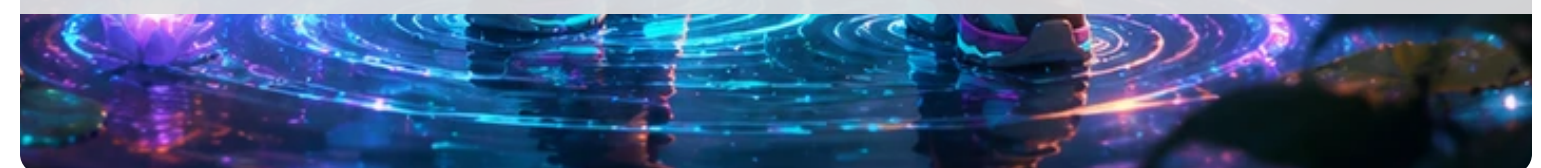
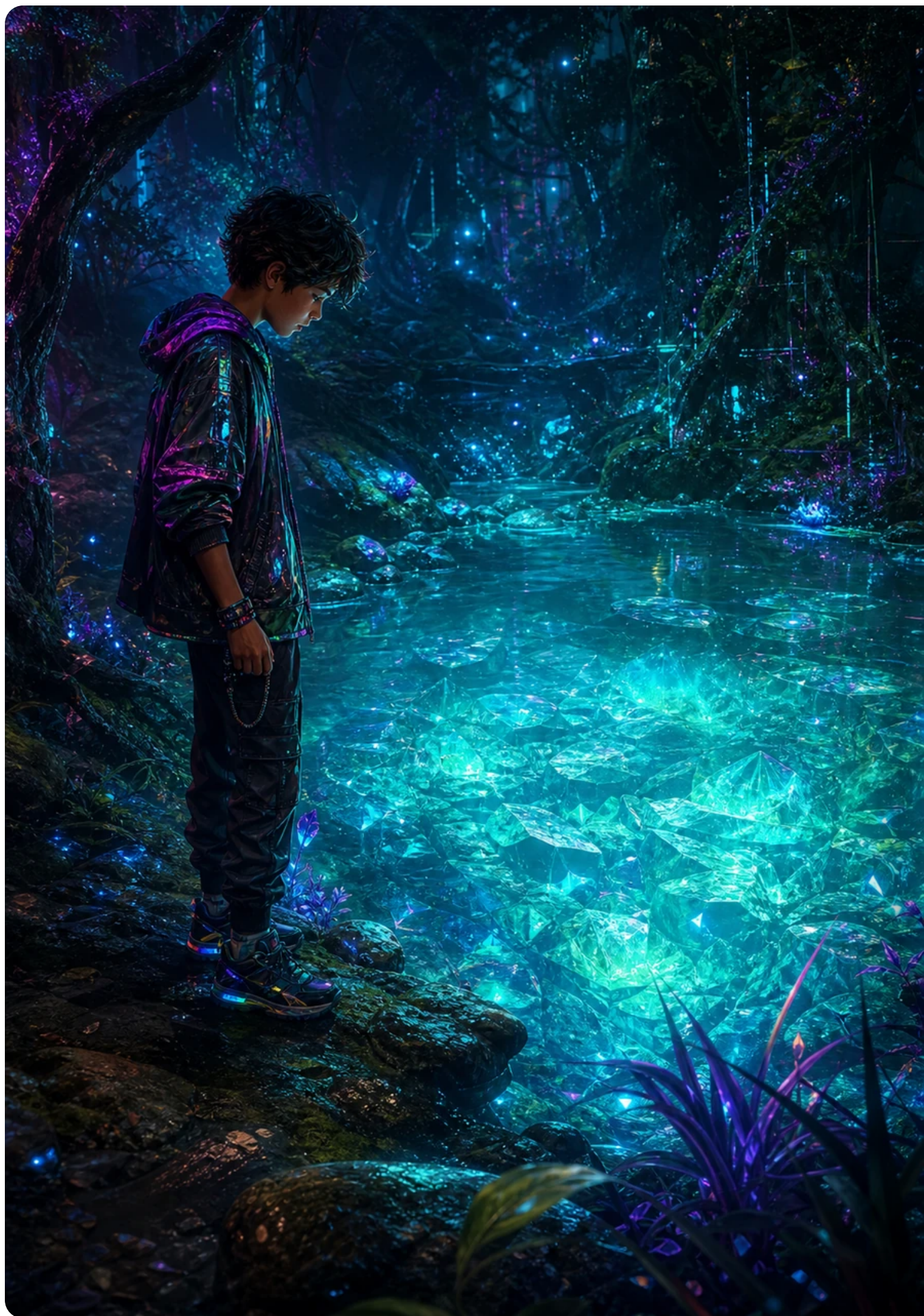




The Ripple Effect
