



# Judy's New Horizon

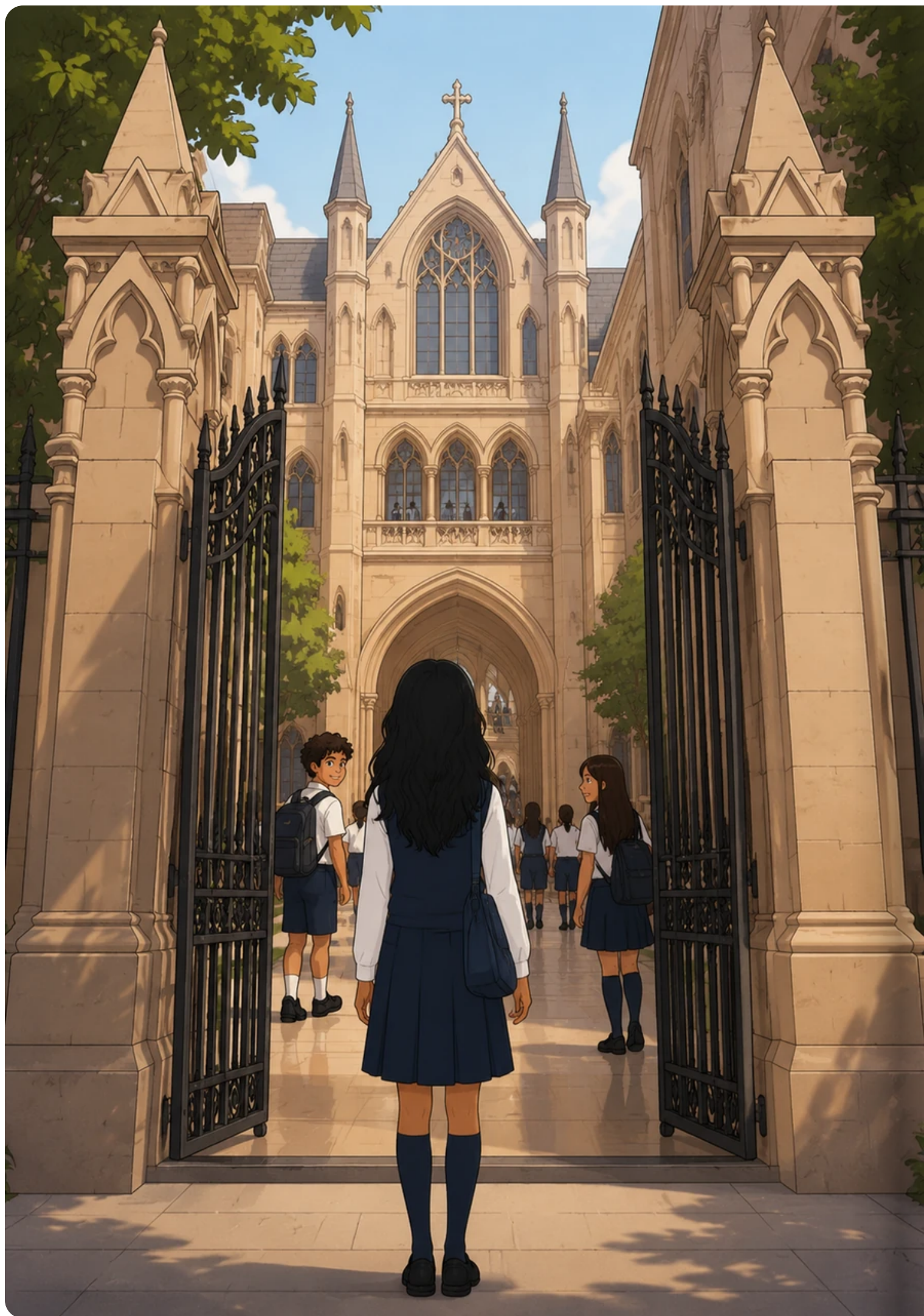
