A Tale of Two Campses

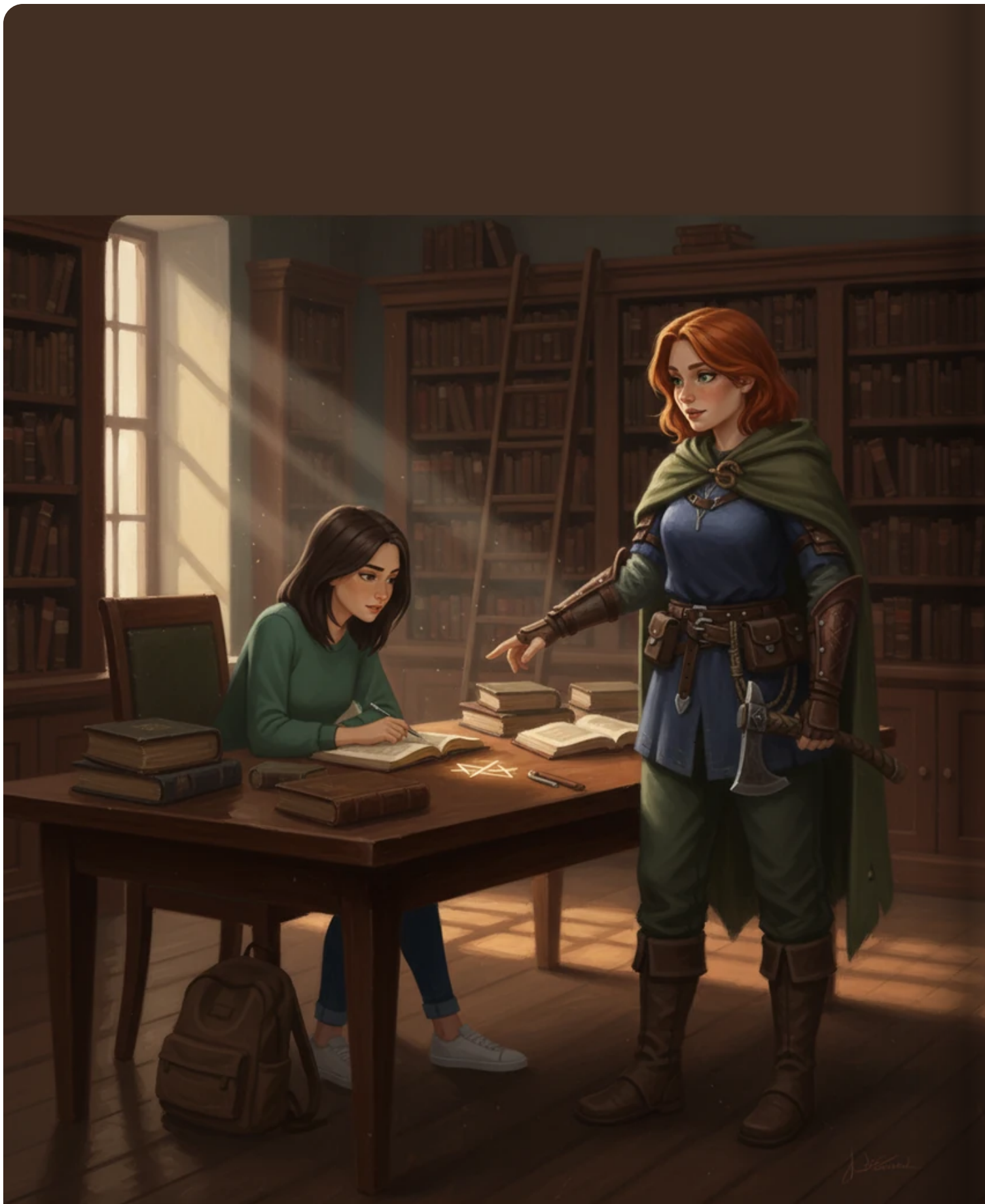


Beyond the Quiet Lines
