

thanksgiving coloring pages




Pip the Squirrel woke up feeling excited. Today was Thanksgiving! He loved the cozy feeling of autumn and the smell of crisp leaves.




First, Pip helped his mom gather delicious food from the garden. They found big, round pumpkins and bright yellow corn.



Pip saw his friend Rosie Rabbit picking juicy red apples. Everyone was busy preparing for the big feast.




Back home, Pip helped stir a big bowl of cranberry sauce. His dad carefully roasted a delicious golden turkey.
