With a brave chirp, Pip flapped small wings as hard as possible. Up, up, up went Pip, trying to reach the sky. The wind tickled Pip's feathers.






Pip took flight again, soaring over a sparkling blue stream. Little fish swam below, making tiny ripples. The water looked cool and inviting.




After more flying, Pip stopped on a smooth, round rock to gaze at the view. The sun felt warm on Pip's back. The tall tree was getting closer now.
