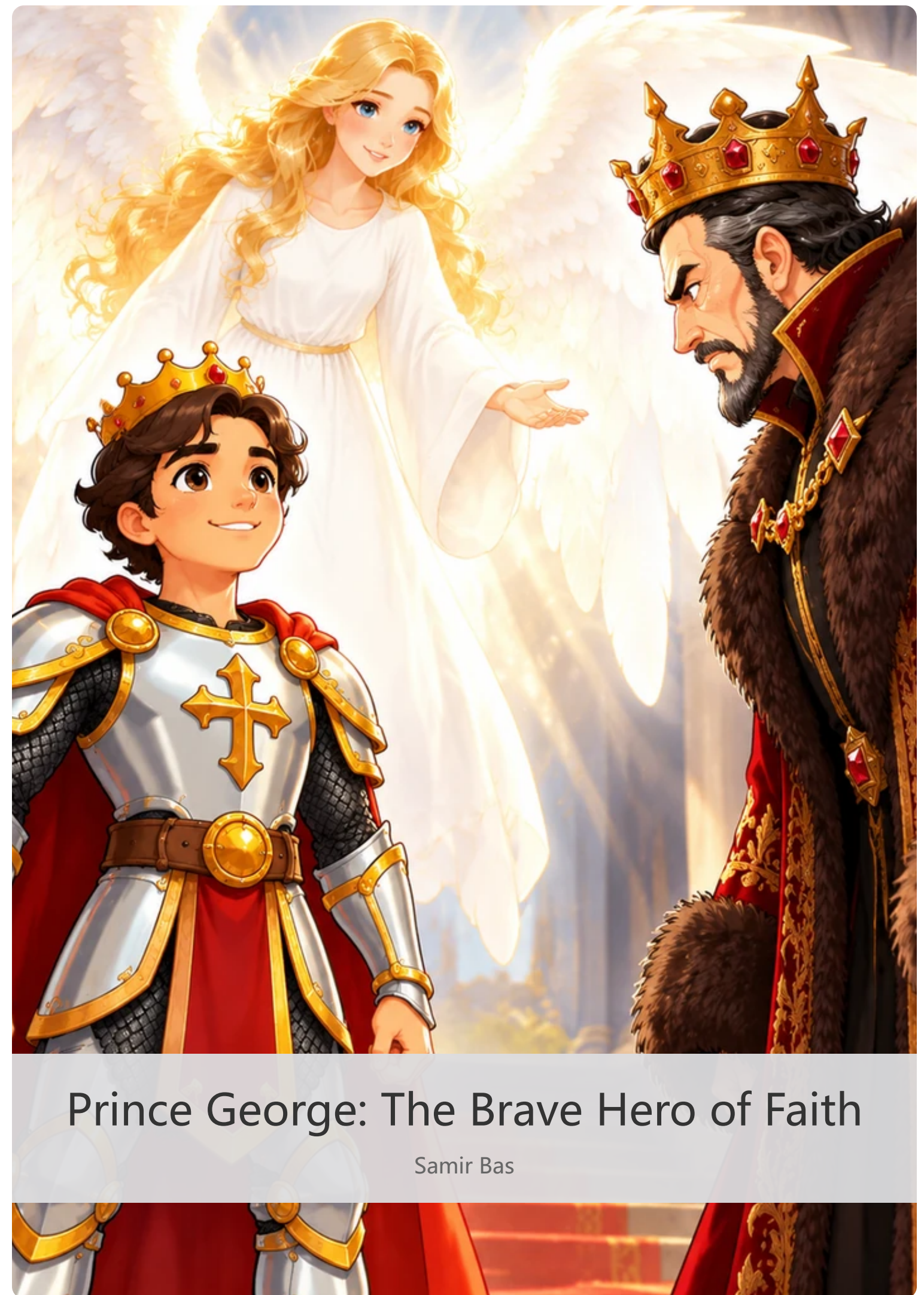




# Prince George: The Brave Hero of Faith
