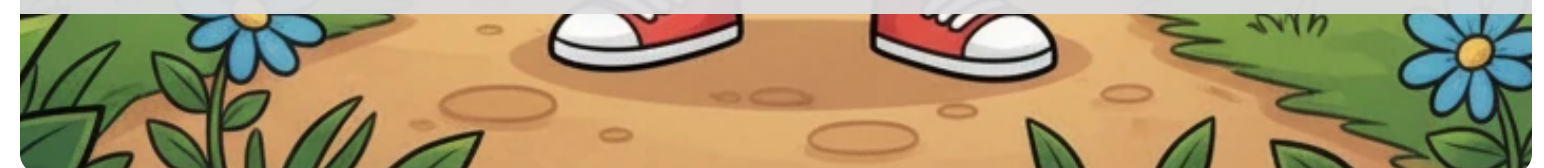




The Little Seedling's Big Dream
