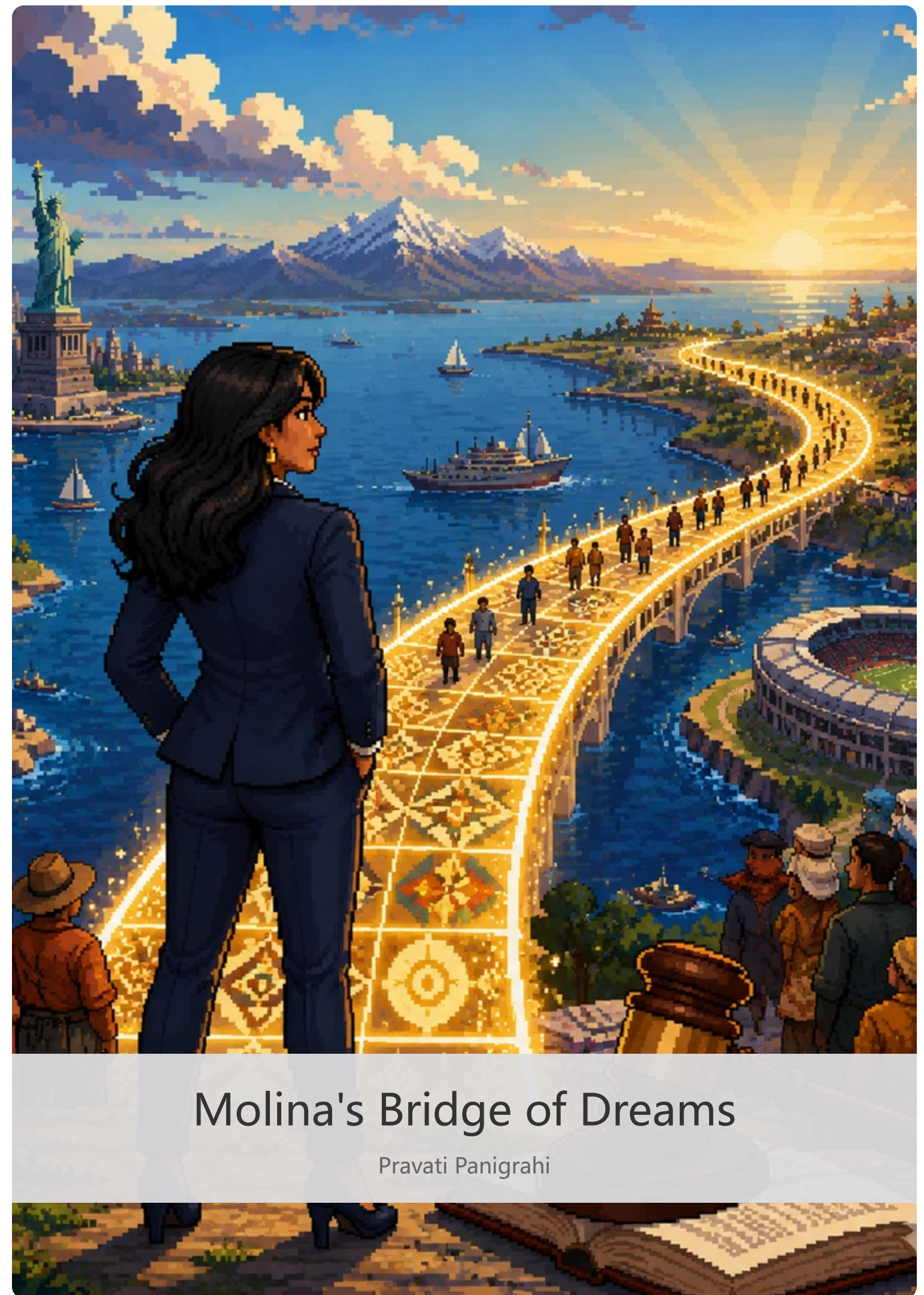




Molina's Bridge of Dreams
