

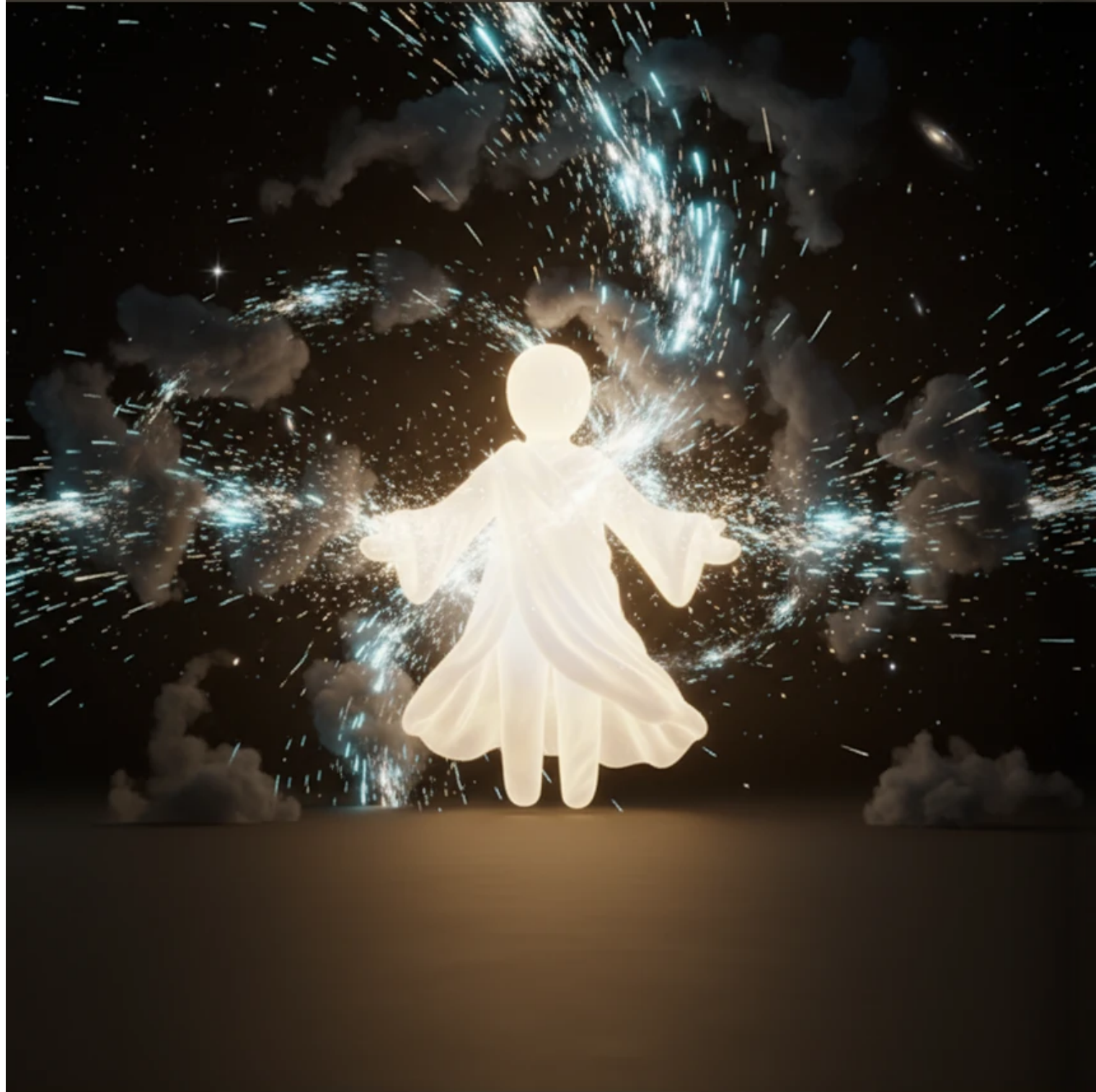


The Beginning of Everything: A Story of Creation
