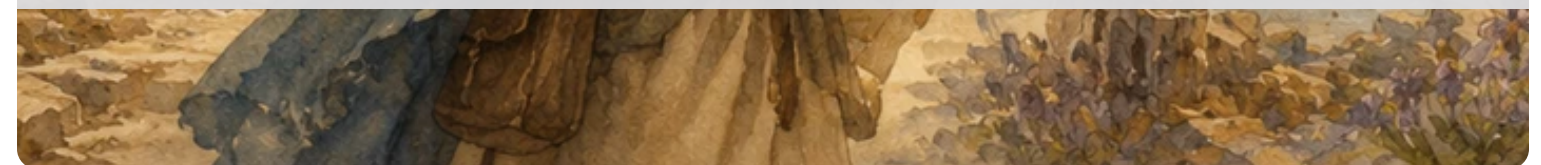




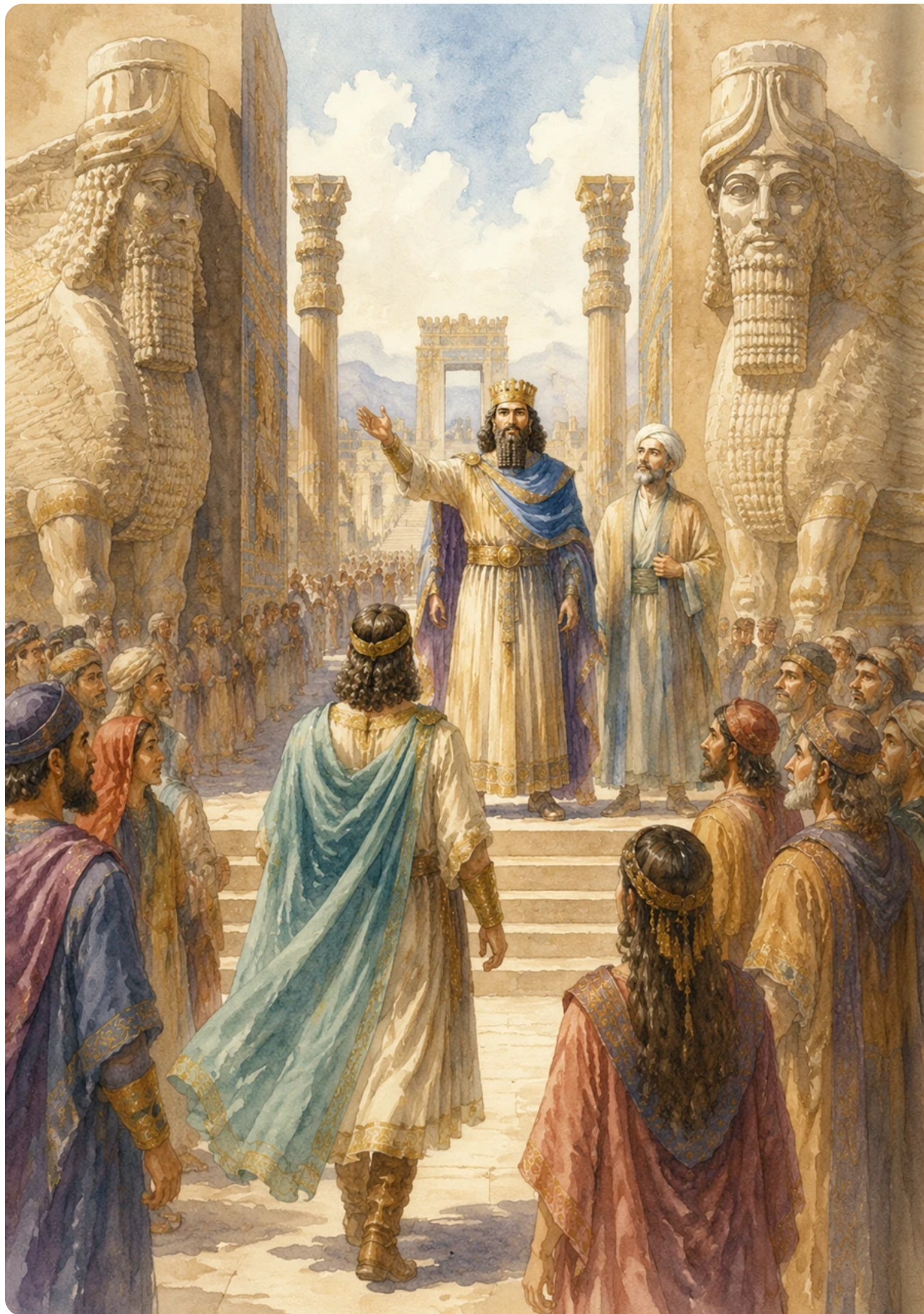
# The Golden Thread: A Journey Through Ancient Persia

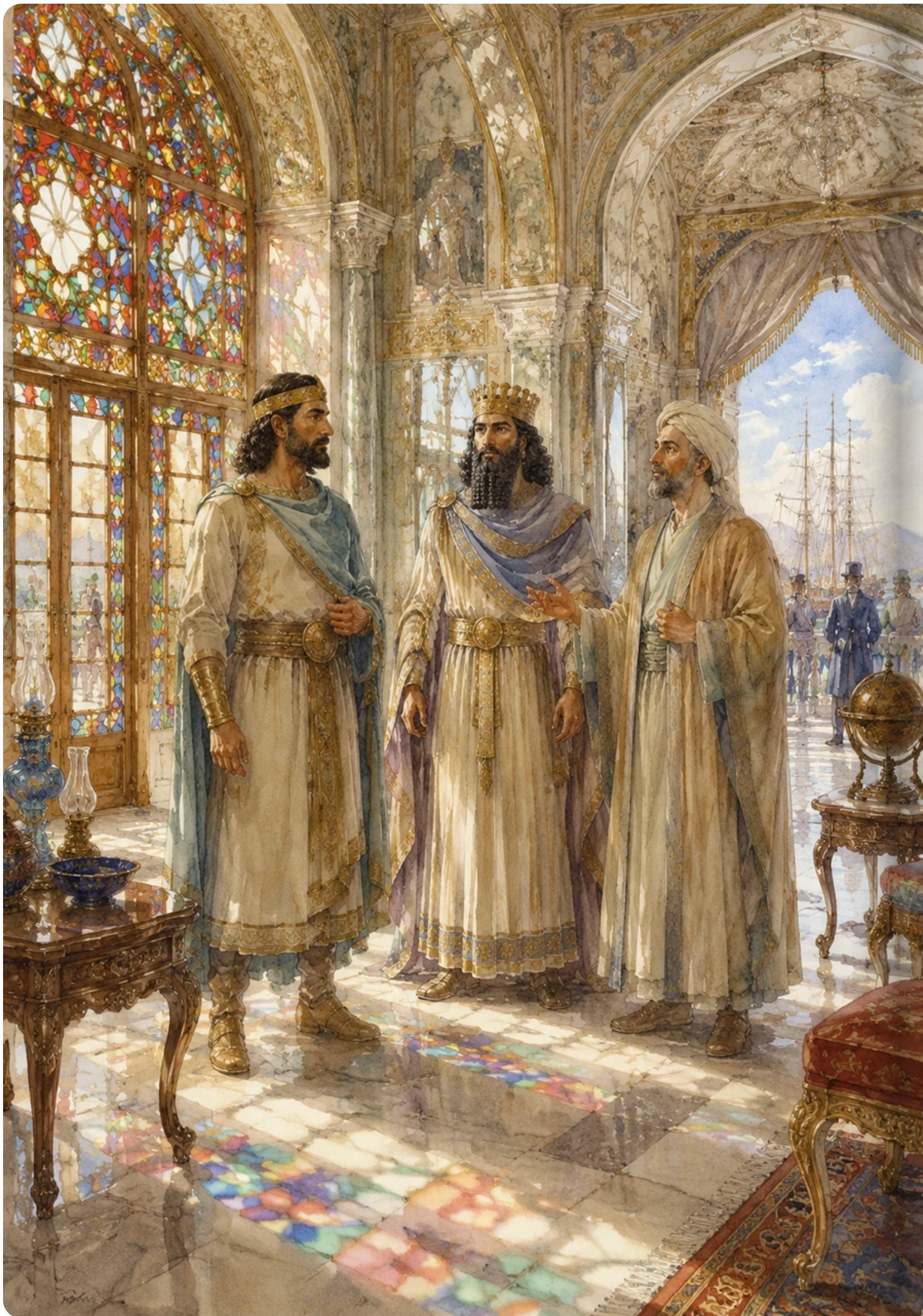
