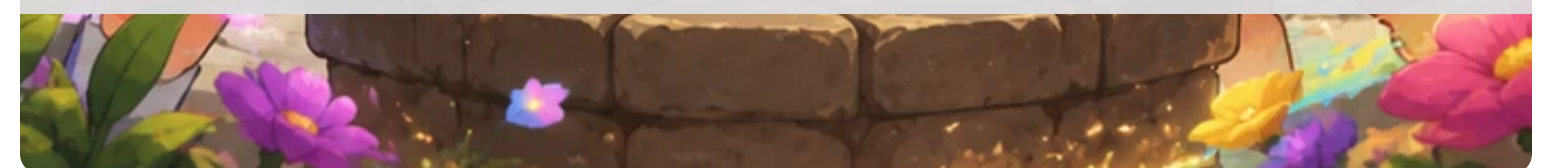




Leo's Colorful Adventure
