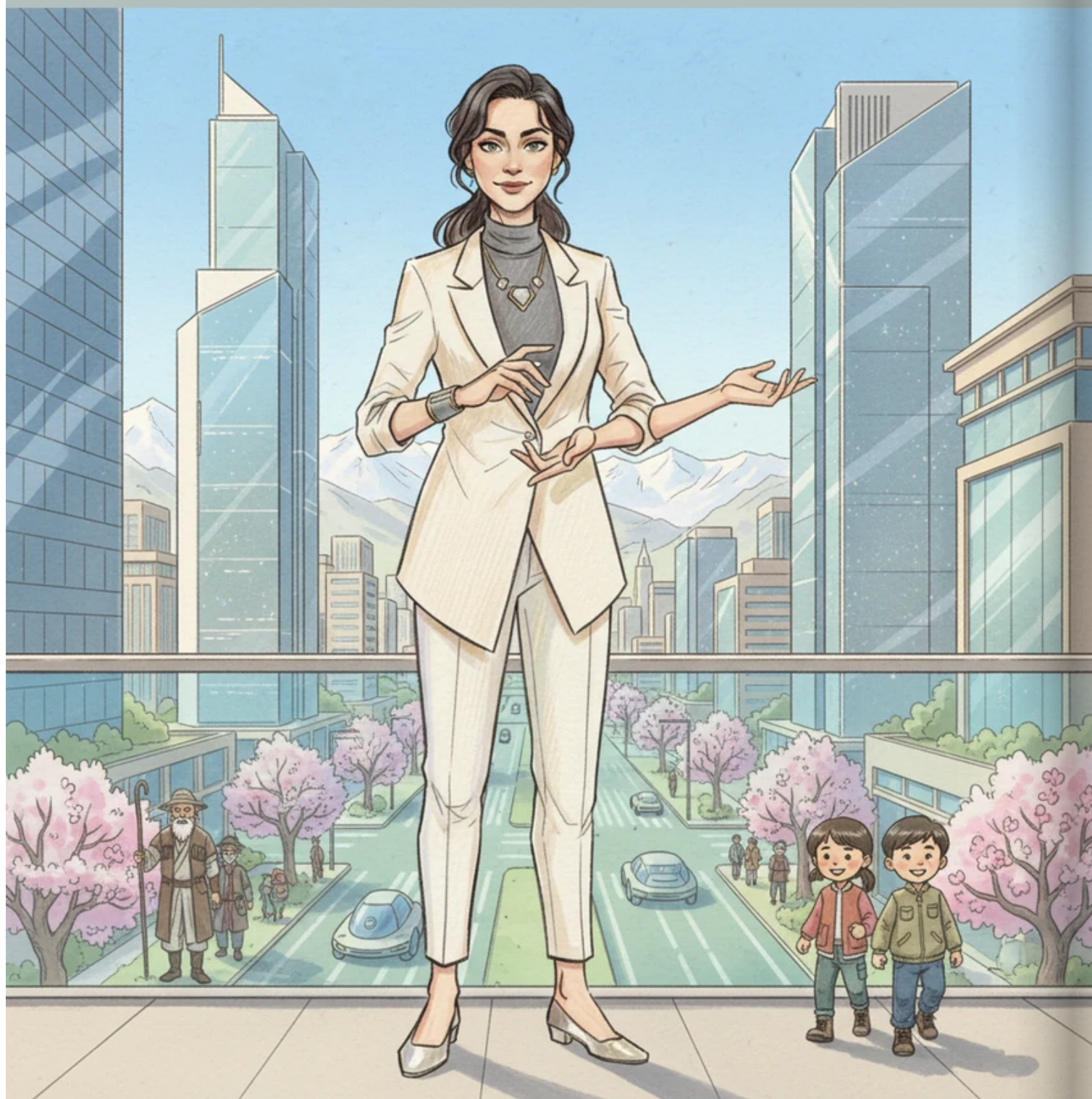




The Golden Valley: A Vision of Modern Kyrgyzstan

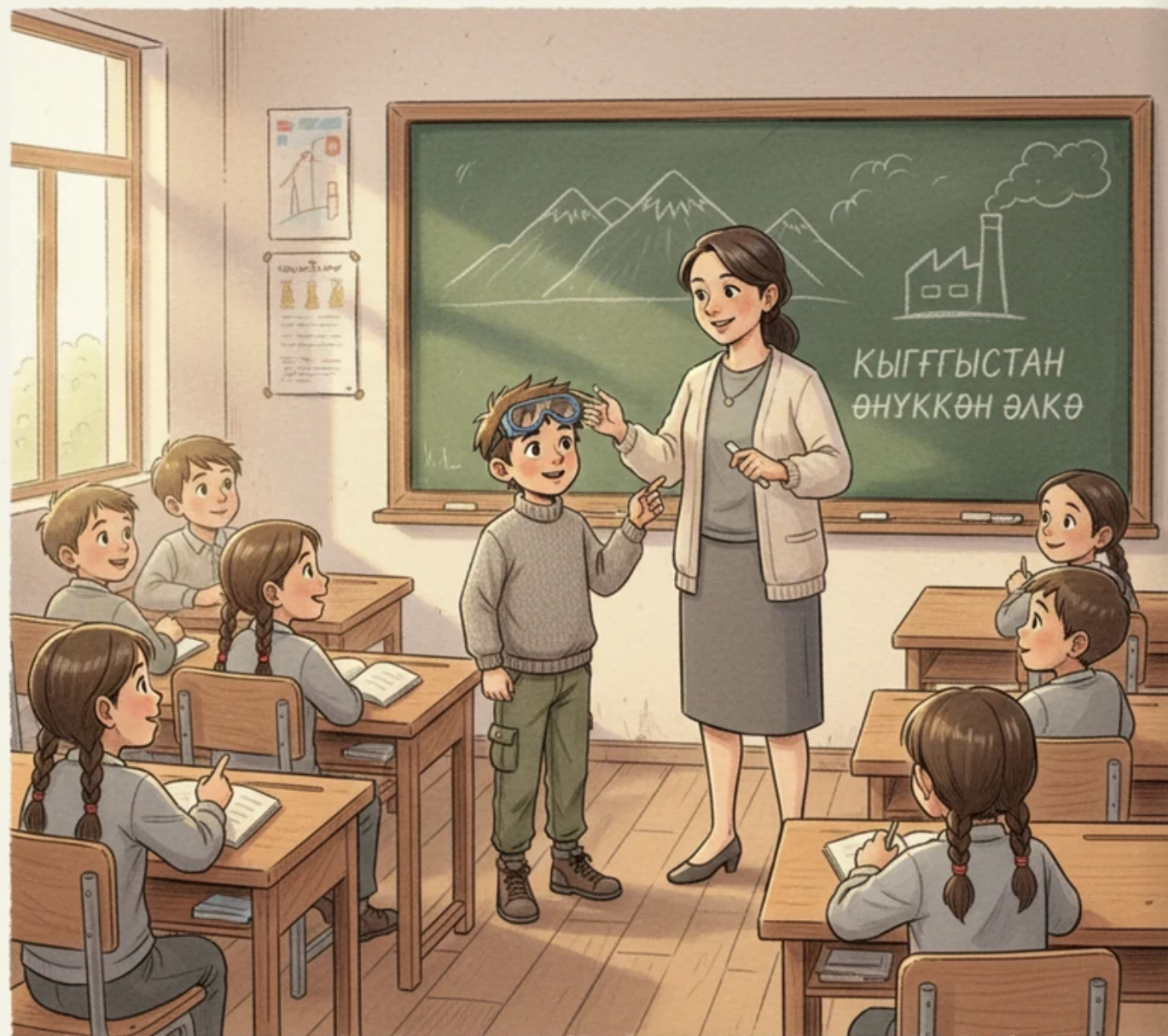
