

Leo's Big Texas Splash

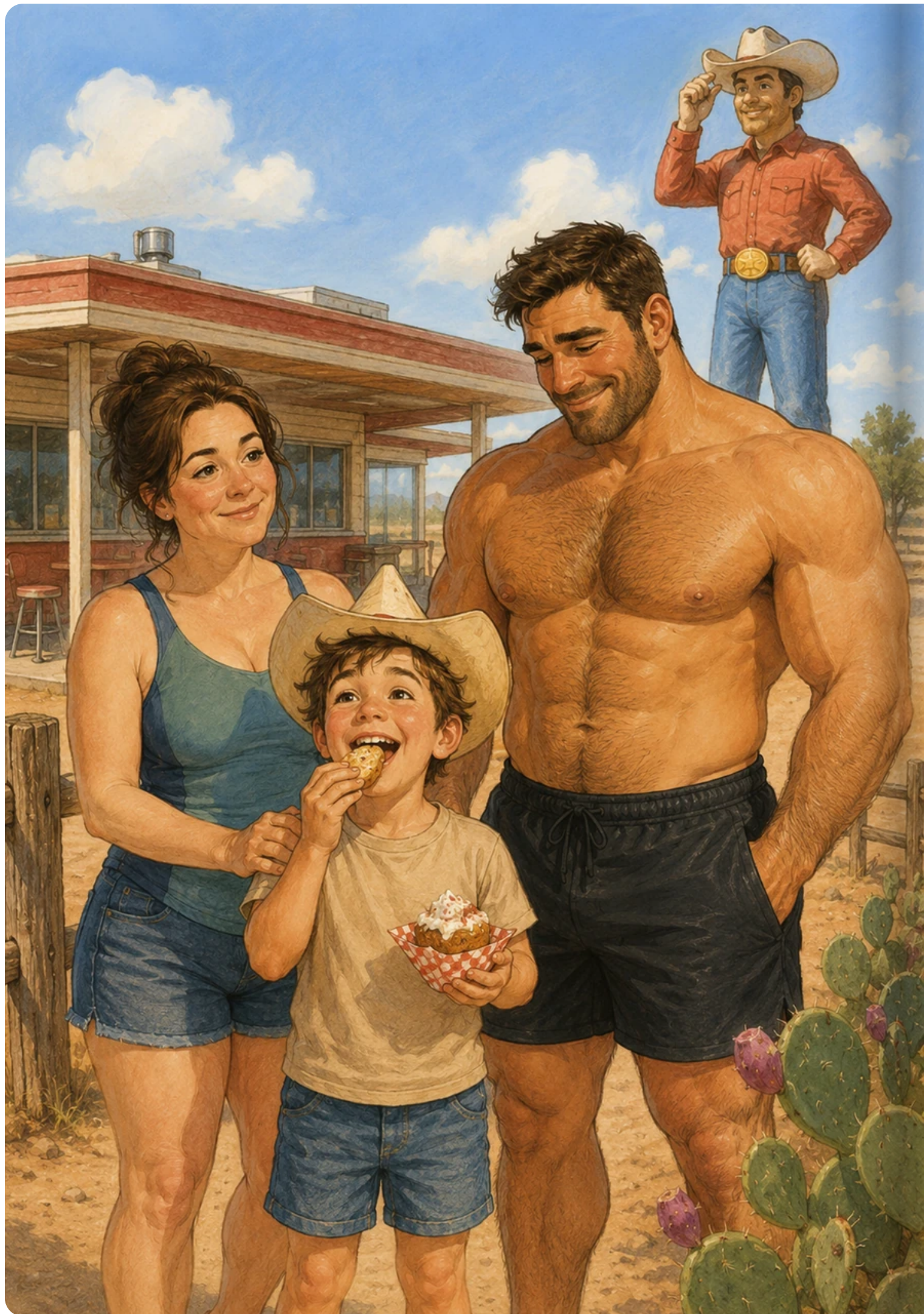
