

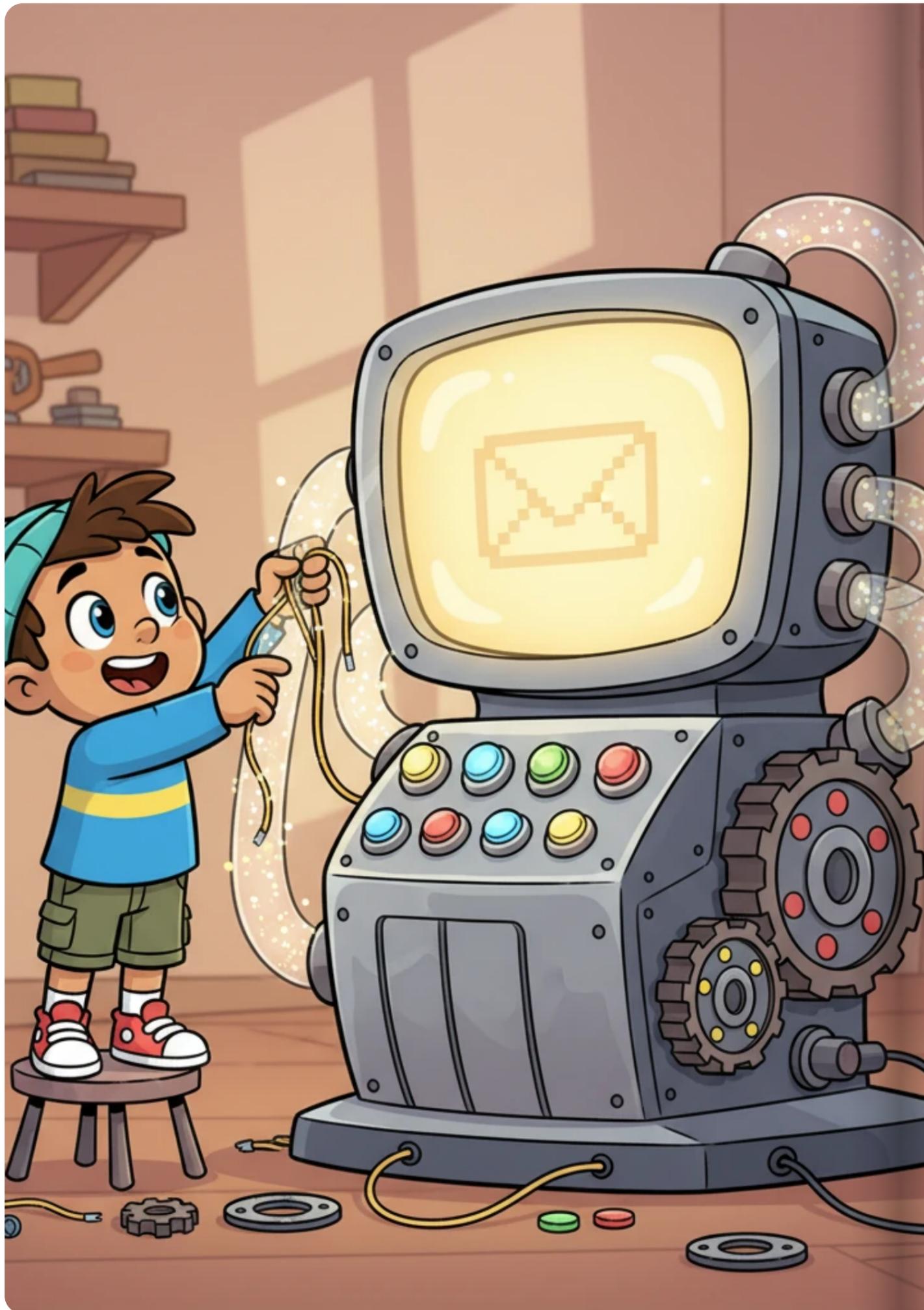


# Pip Pixel and the Message Manager
