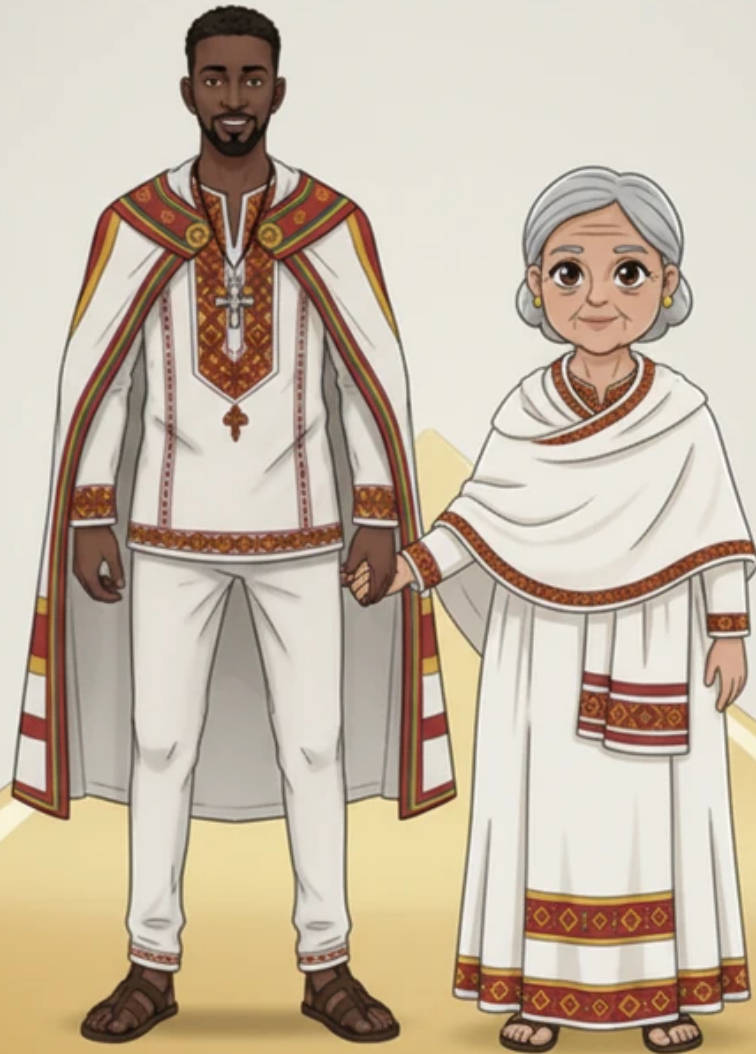


Runway of Parenting



The Runway of Parenting: Preparing for the Flight of a Lifetime

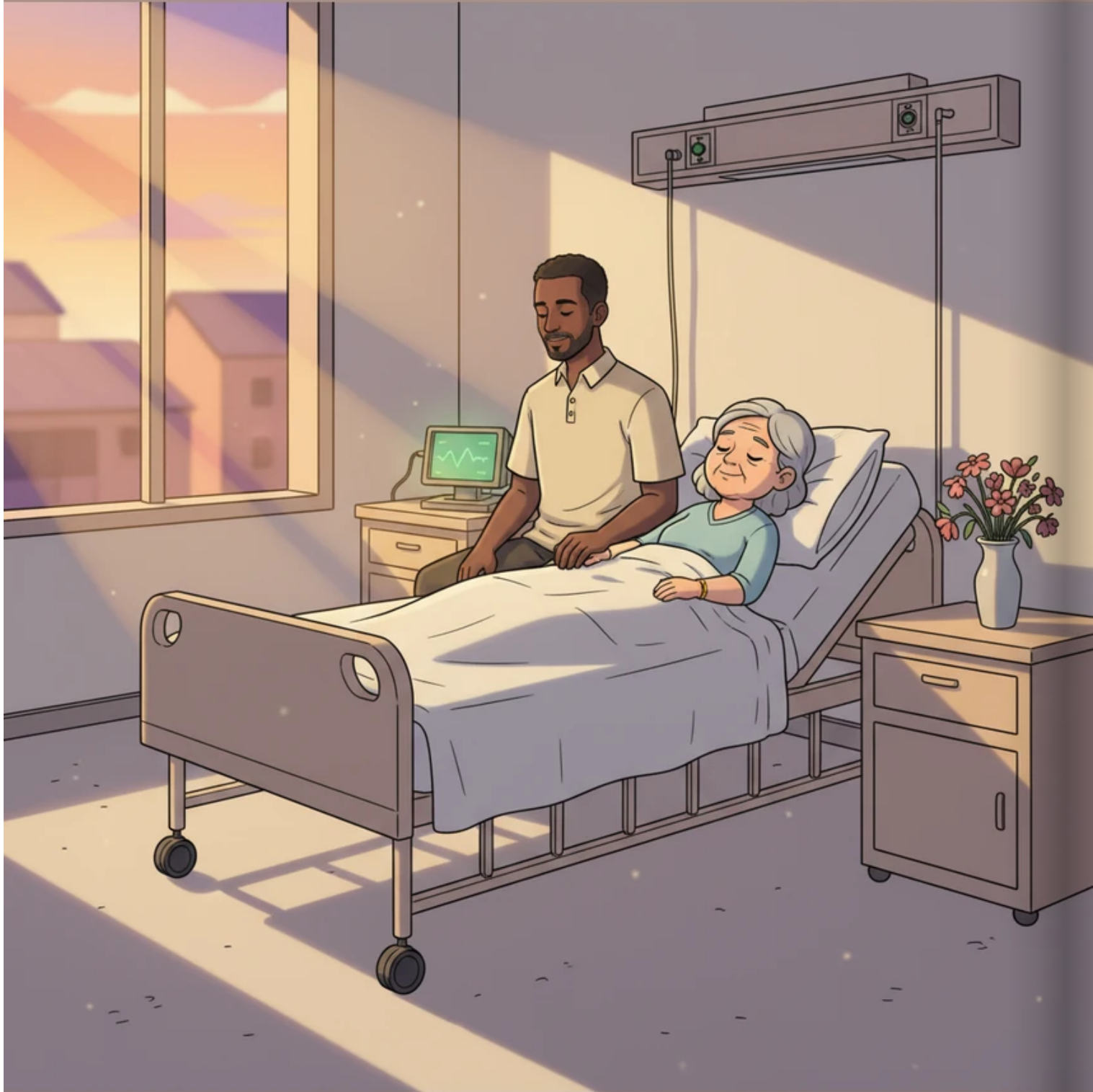
