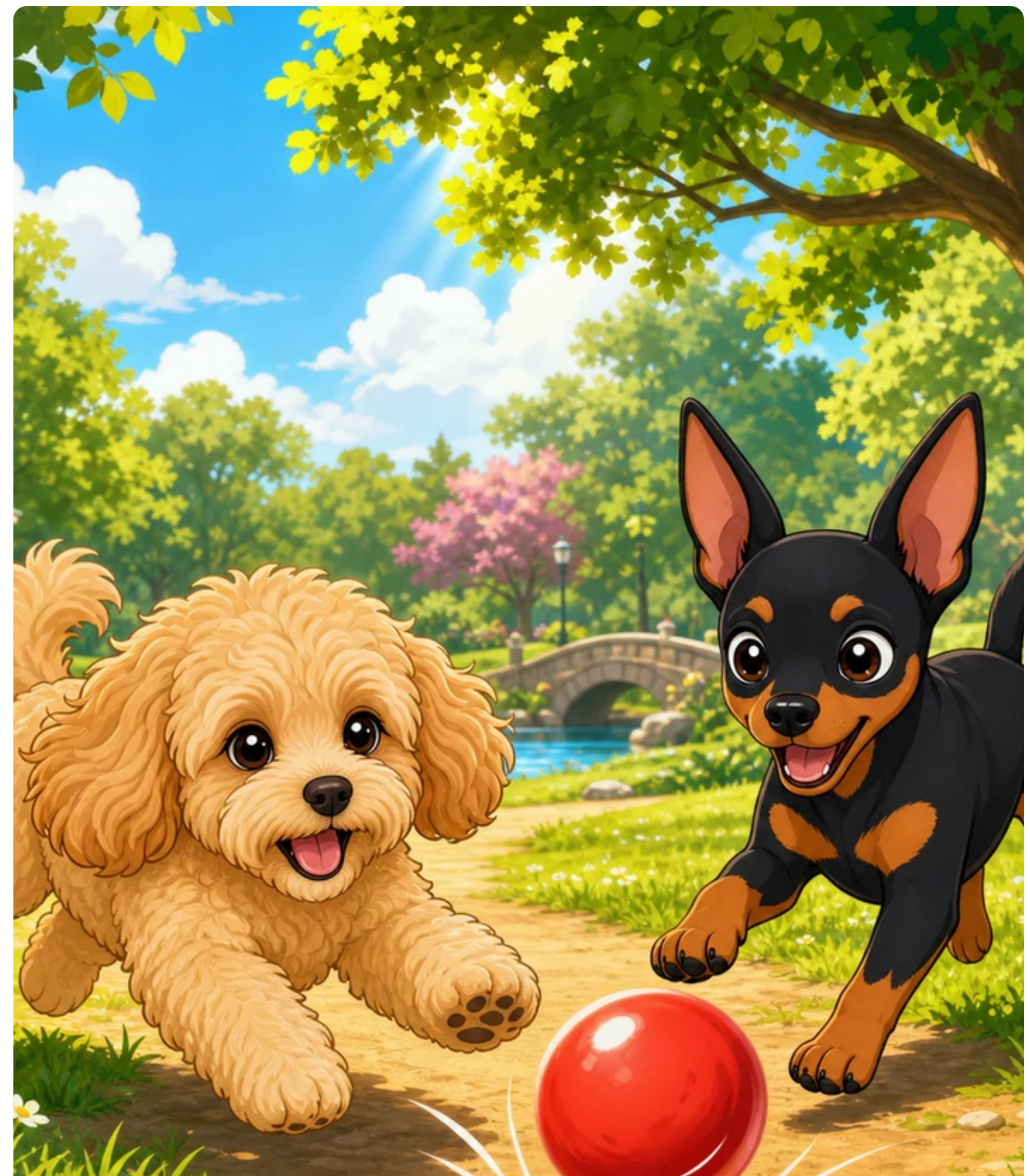




Daisy and Duke's Big Park Adventure
