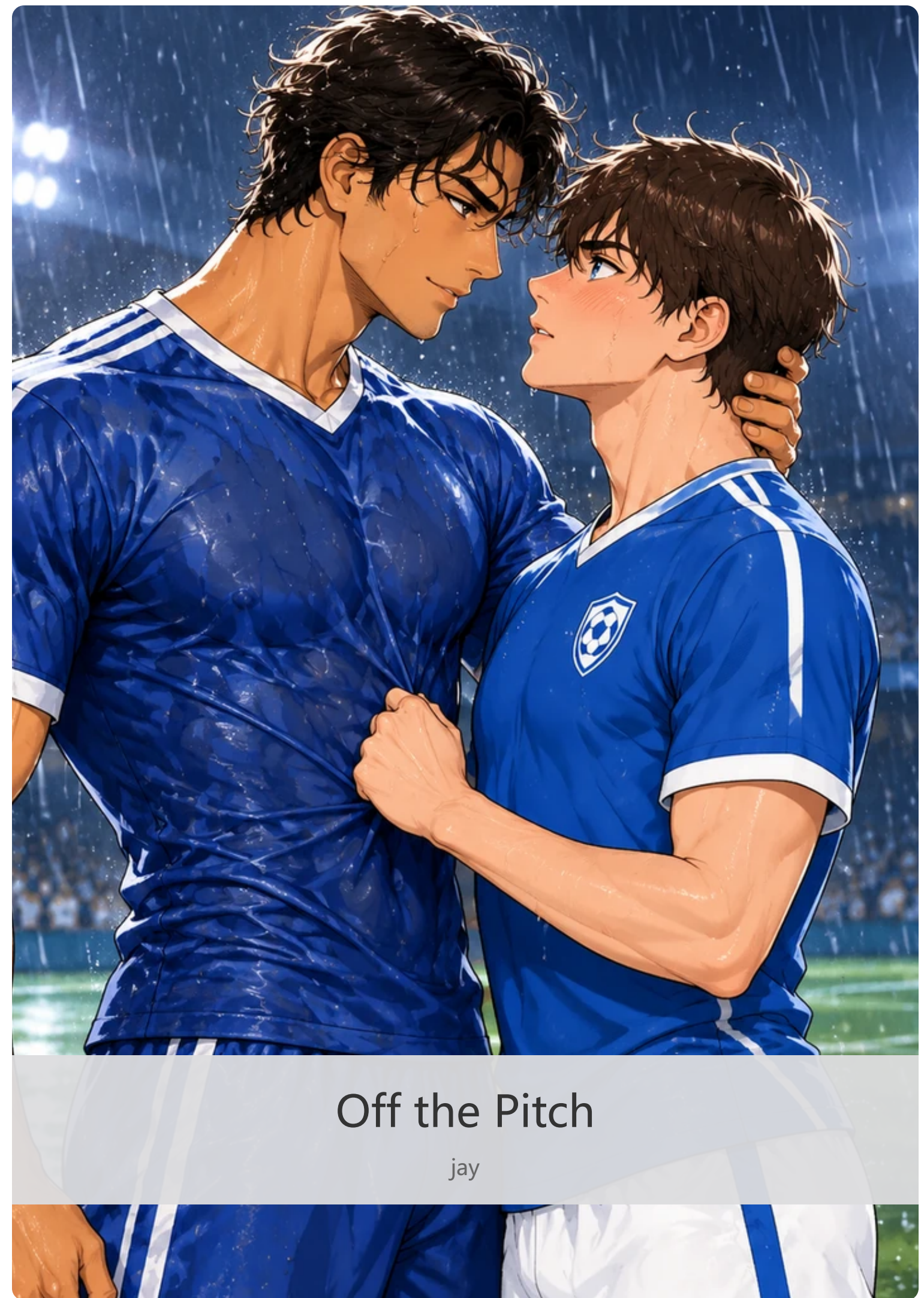




Off the Pitch
