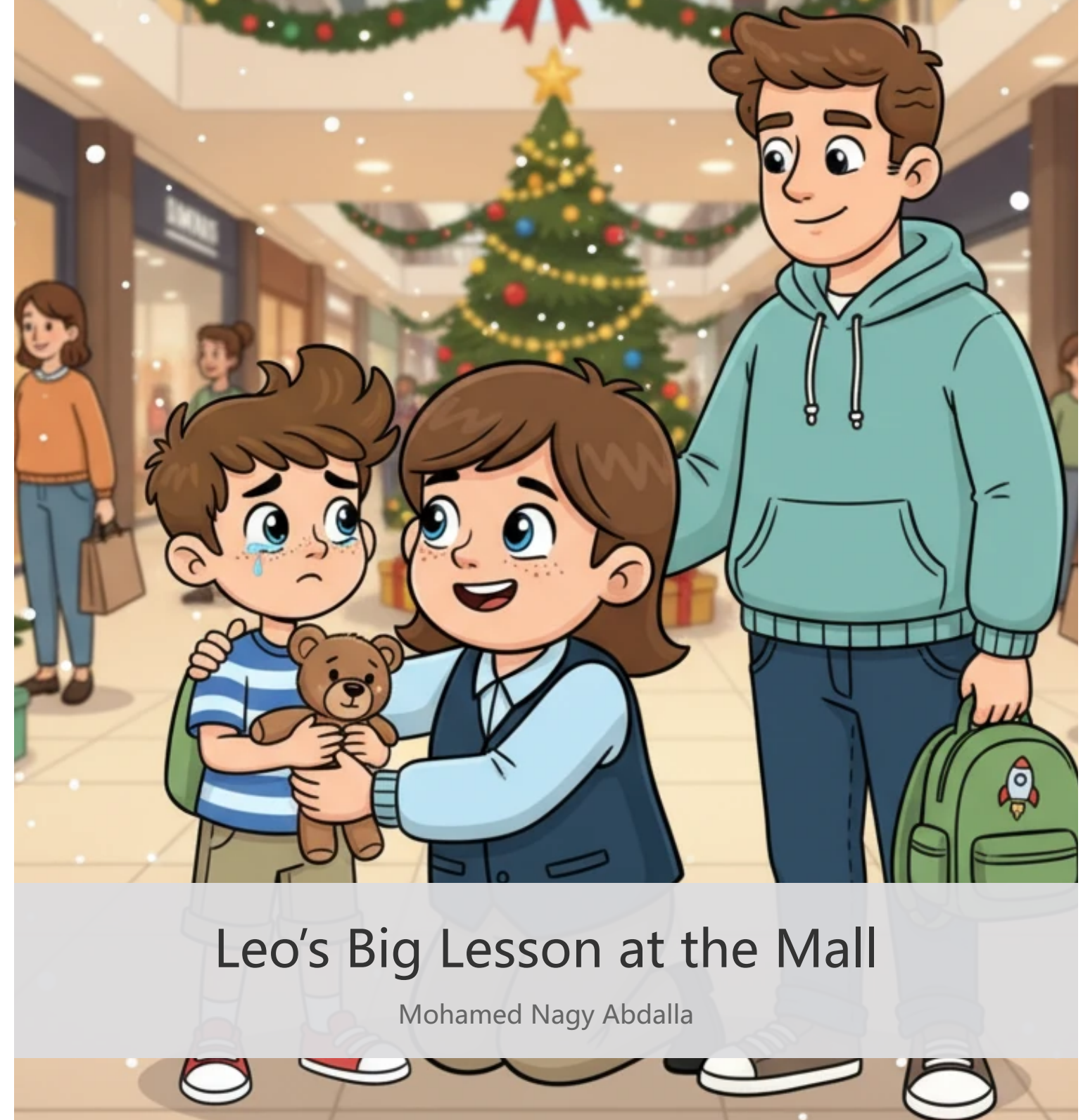
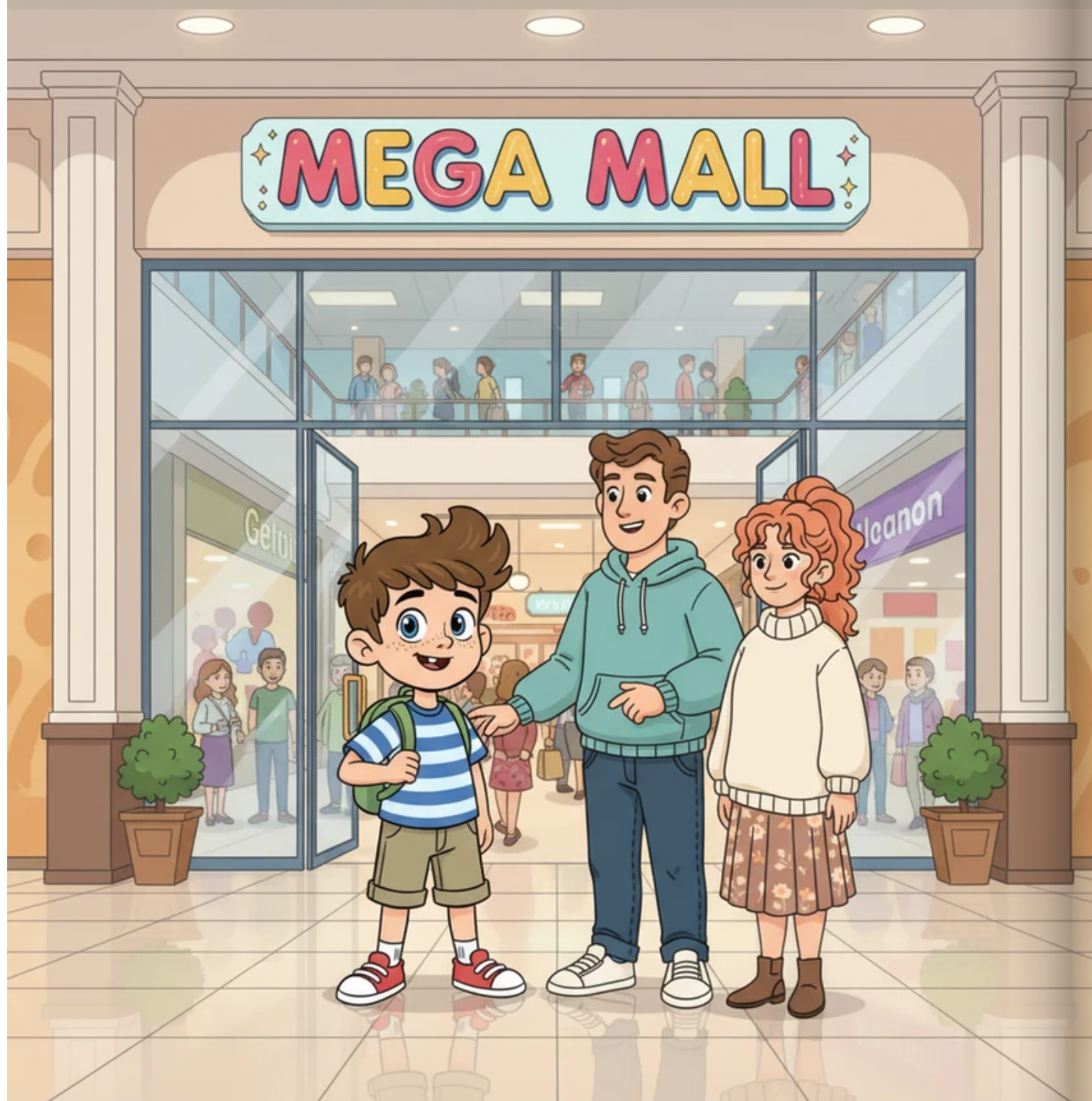


# CHRISTMAS MIRACLE AT THE MALL
