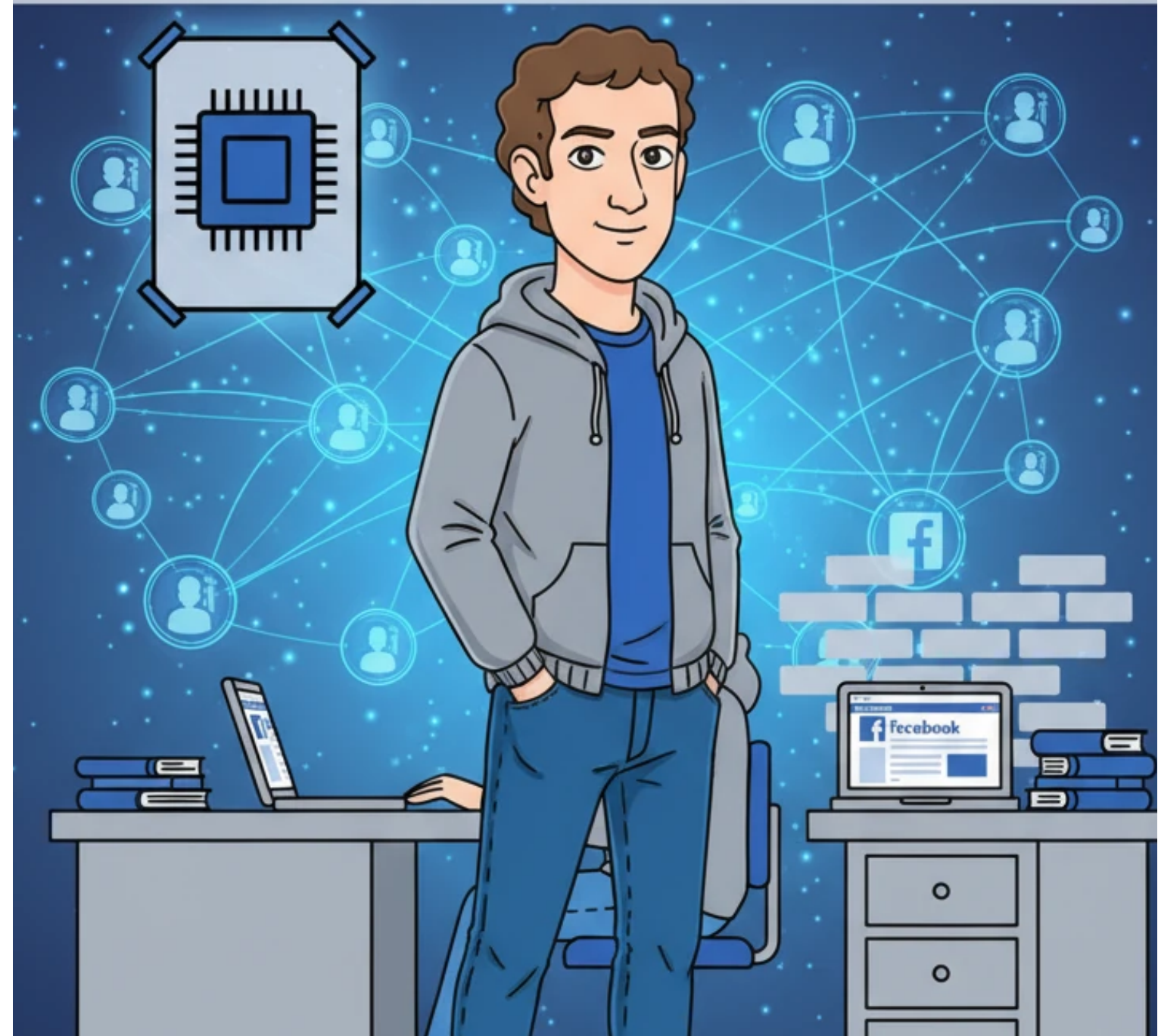


THE SOCIAL NETWORK BUILDER

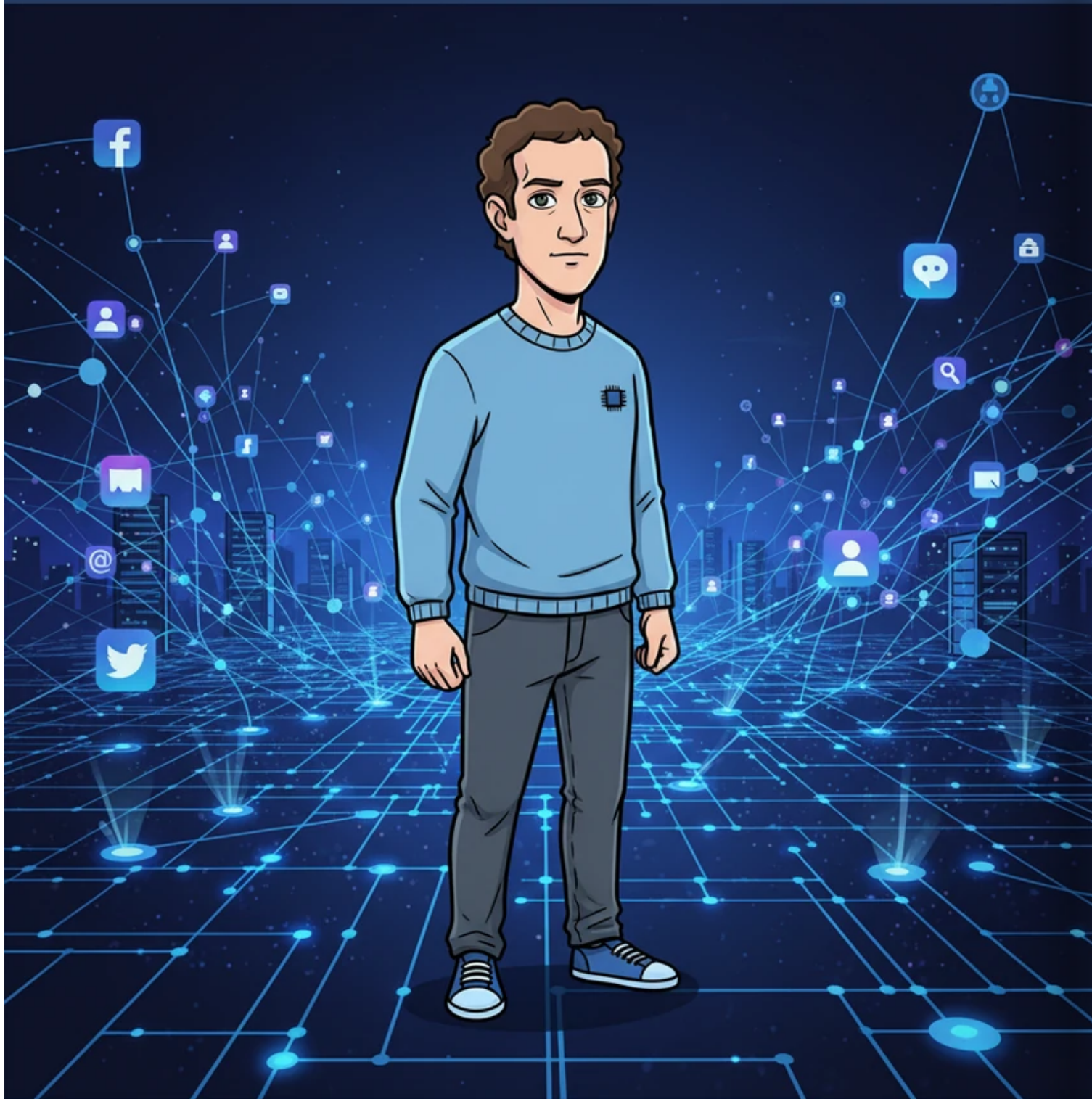
