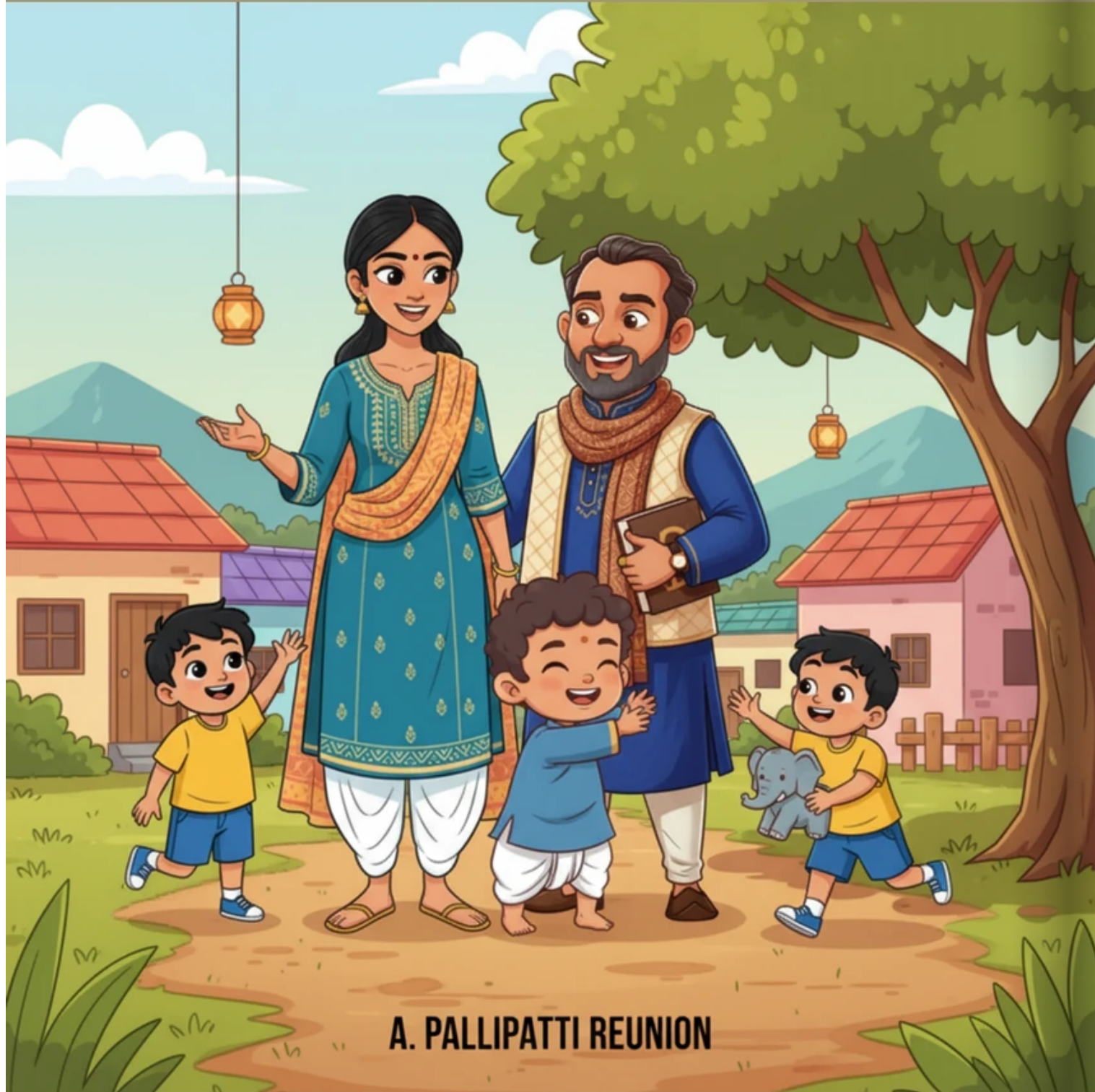


FAMILY AT DADA'S HOUSE
