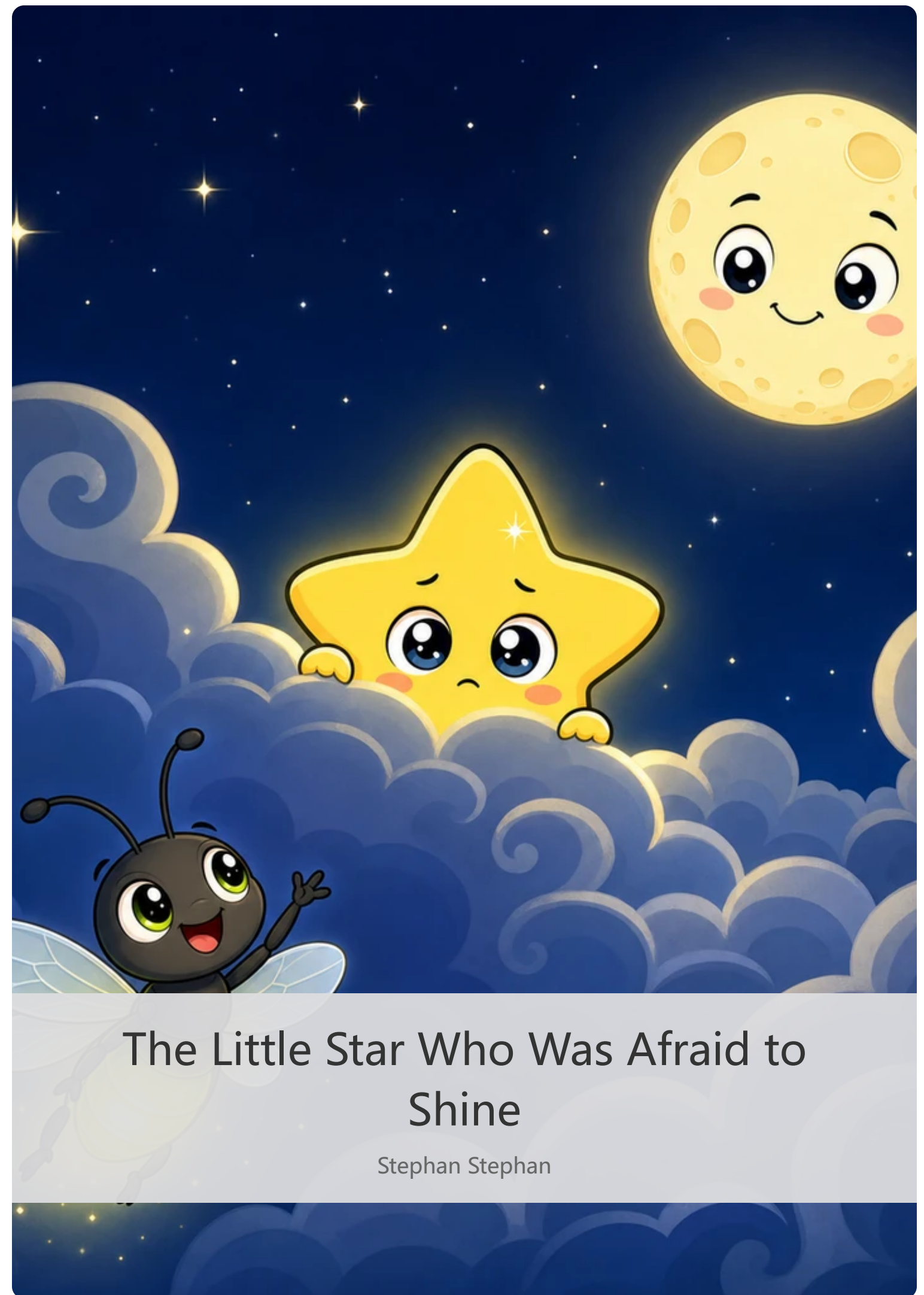




The Little Star Who Was Afraid to Shine

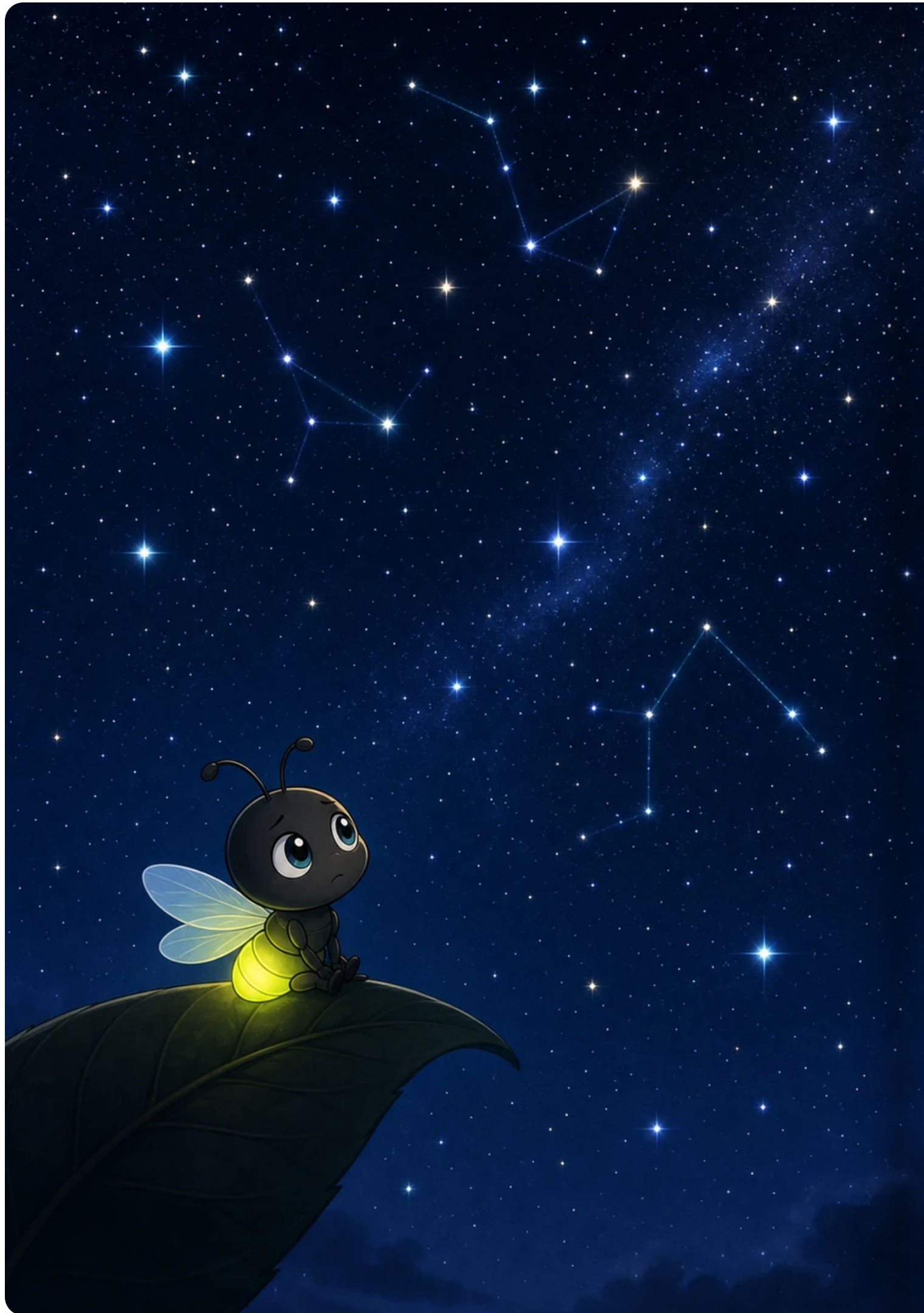
