



Cody the Brave Little Carrot

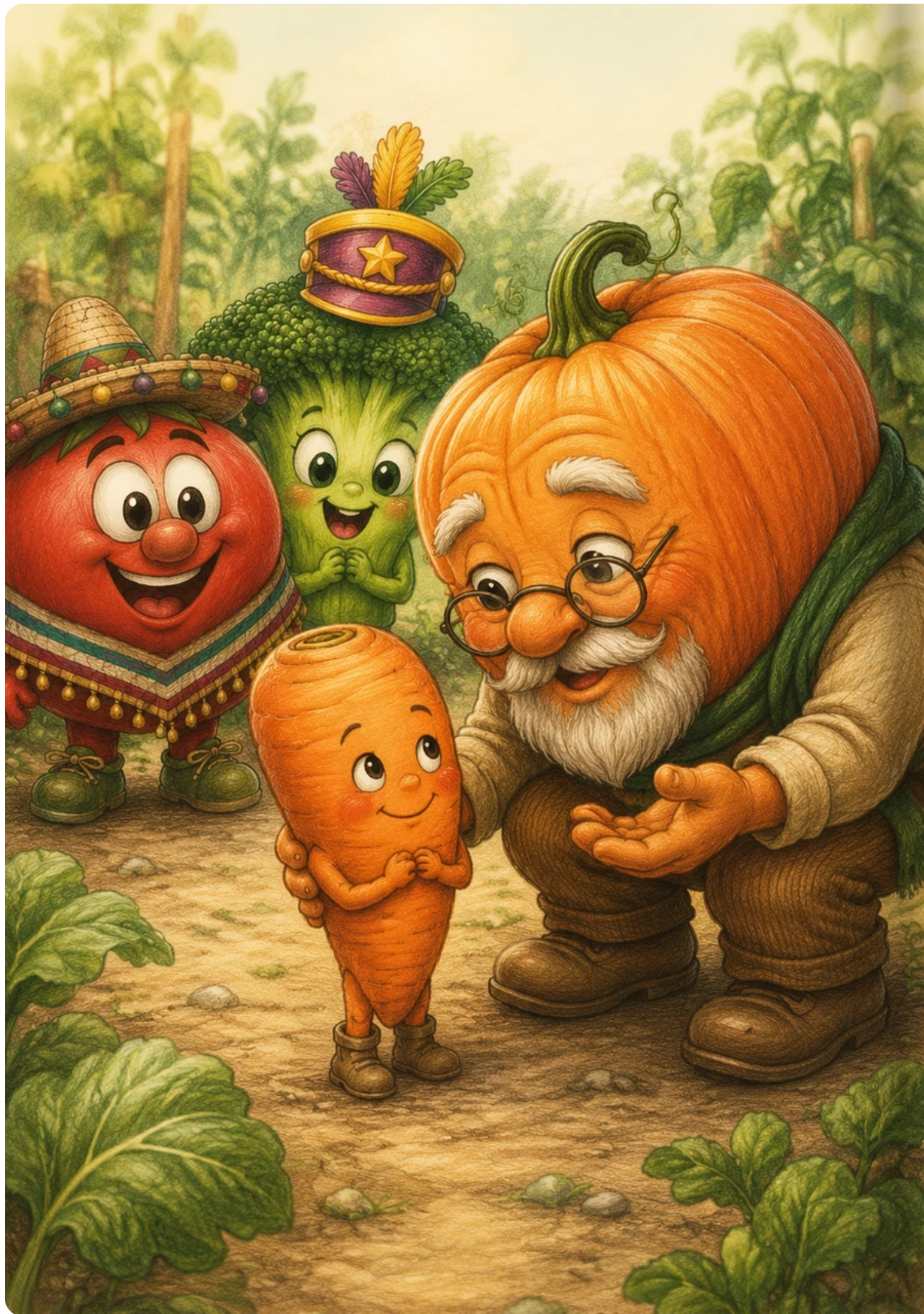
