



Rex Can Flex!

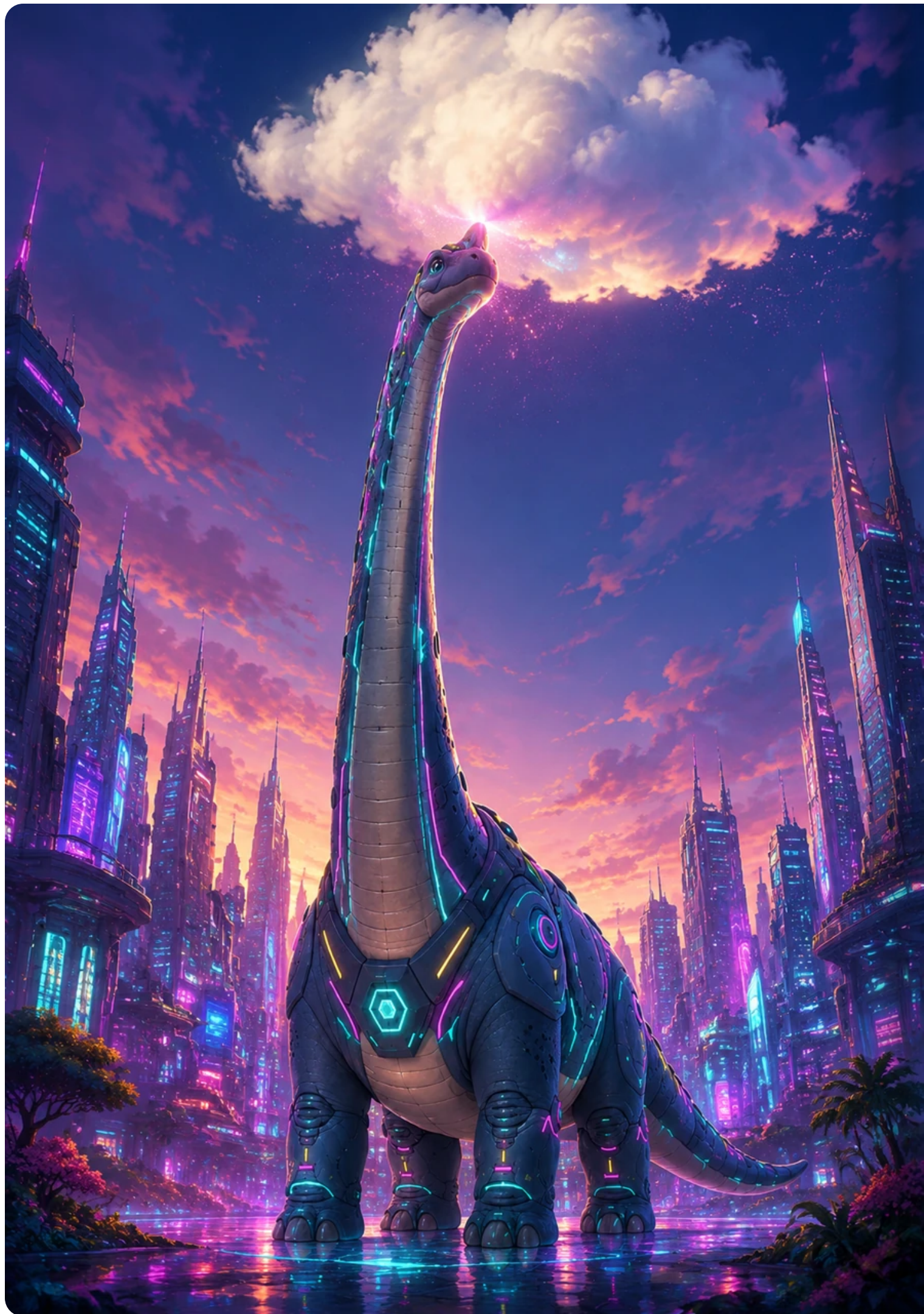
