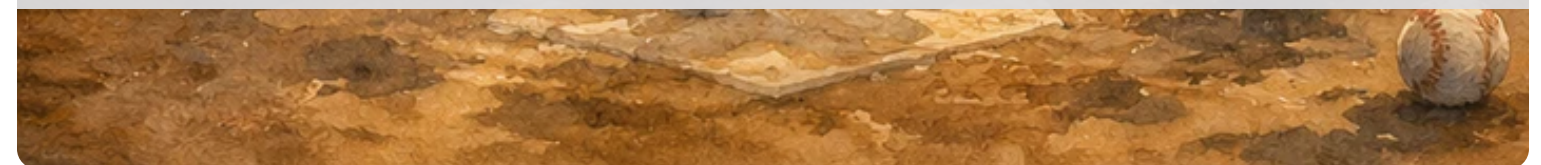




The Benchwarmers: Legends of the Diamond

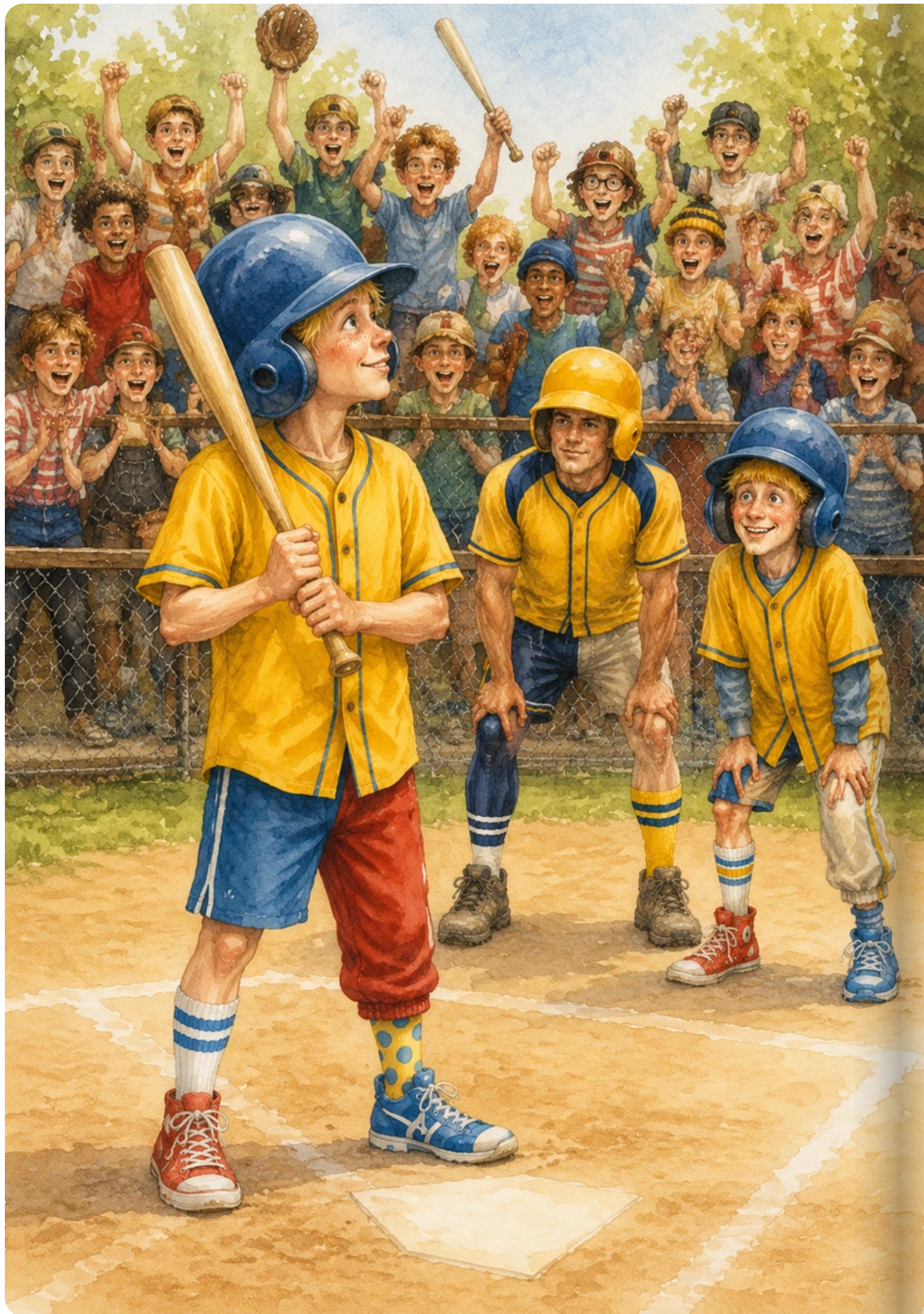
