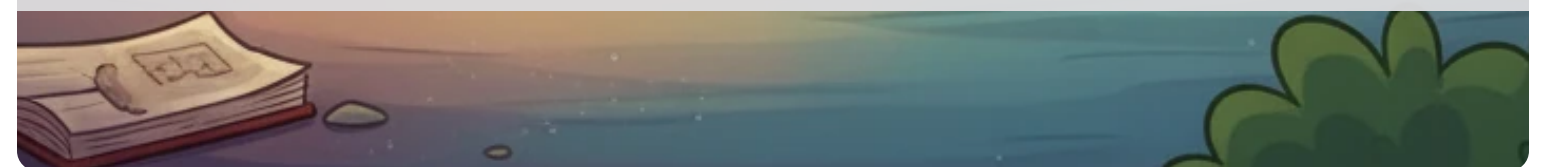




# Leo's Legacy Quest
