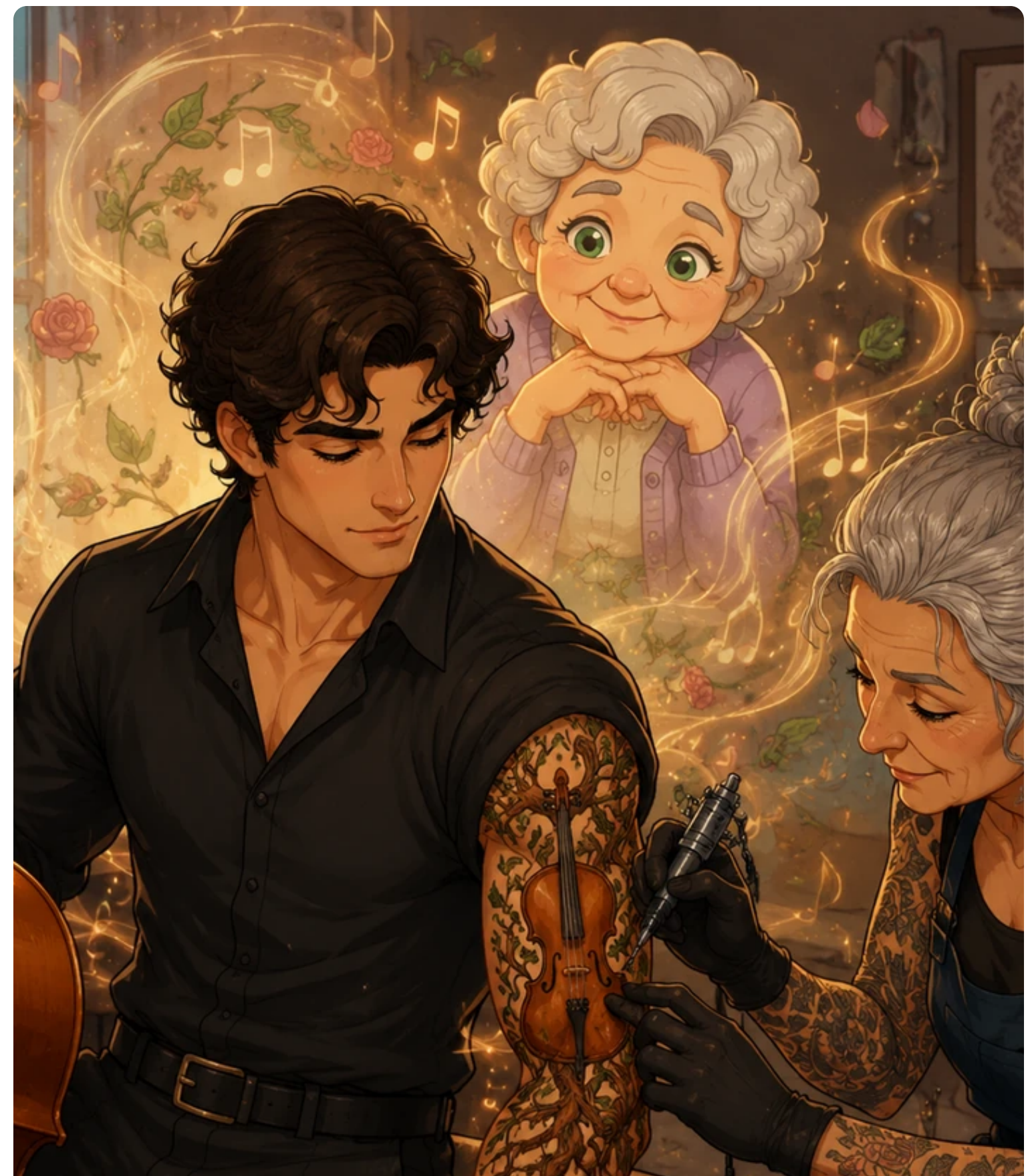
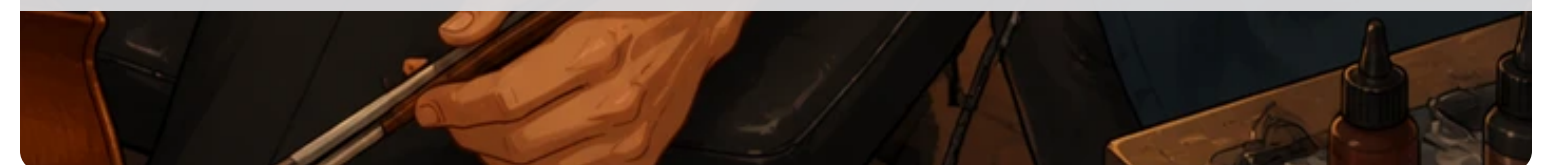




The Symphony Within
