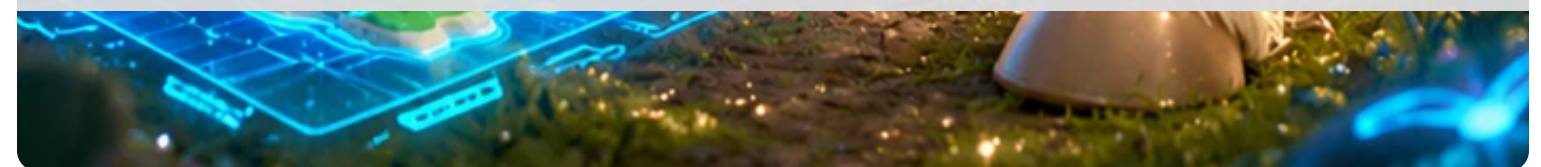




# Sasha and the Neon Phoenix
