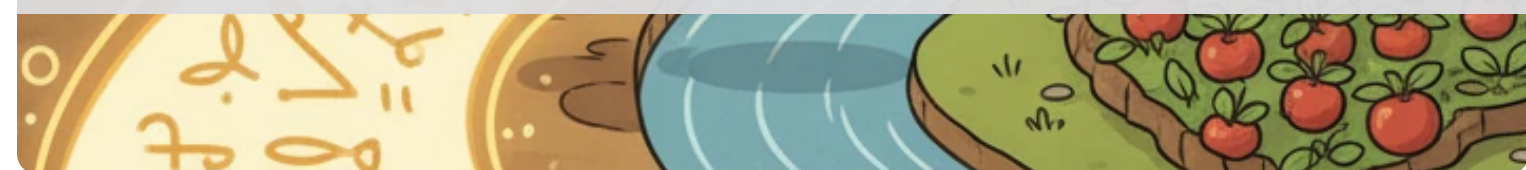


# The Magic Book and Raju's Hard Work
