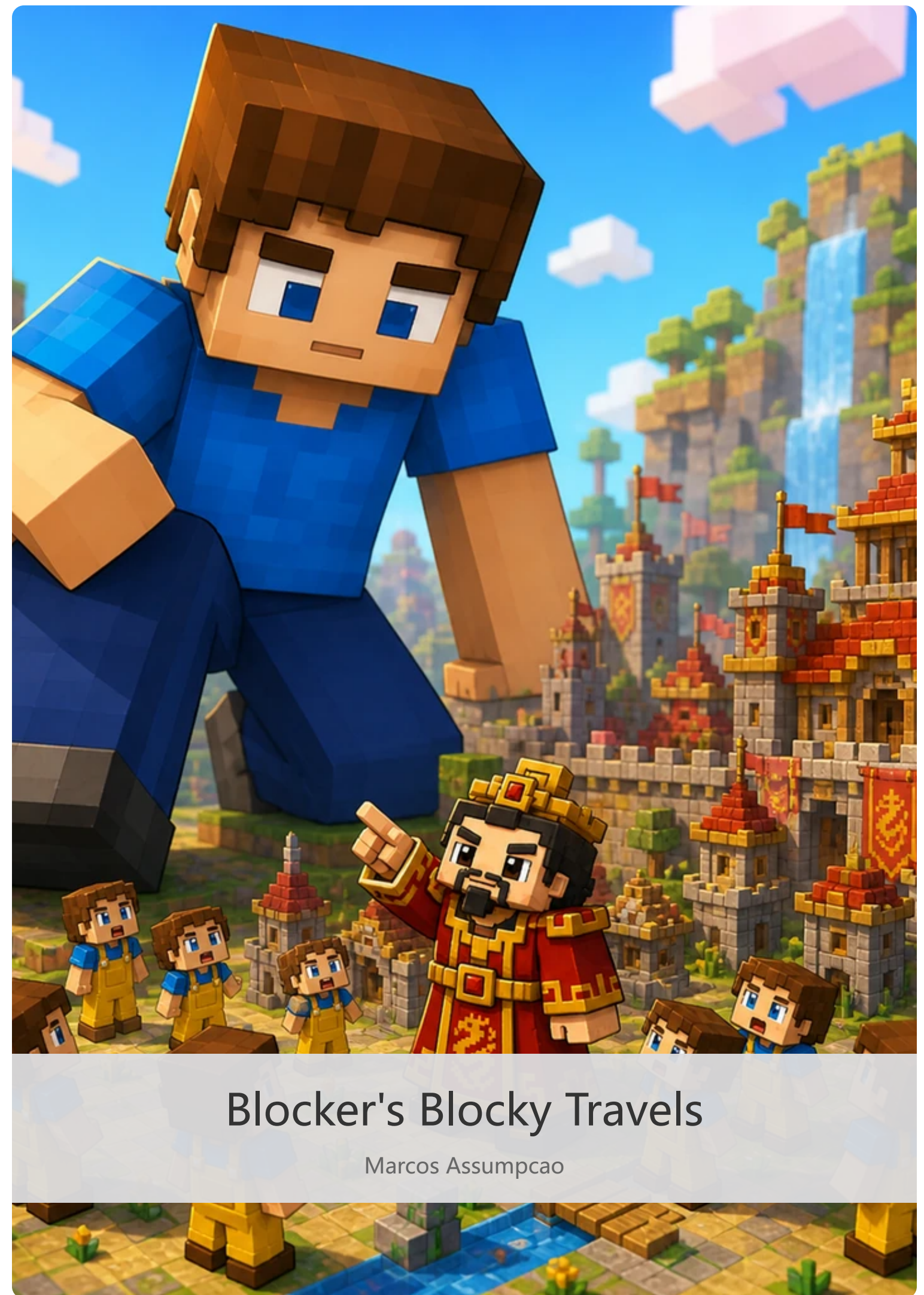




Blocker's Blocky Travels
