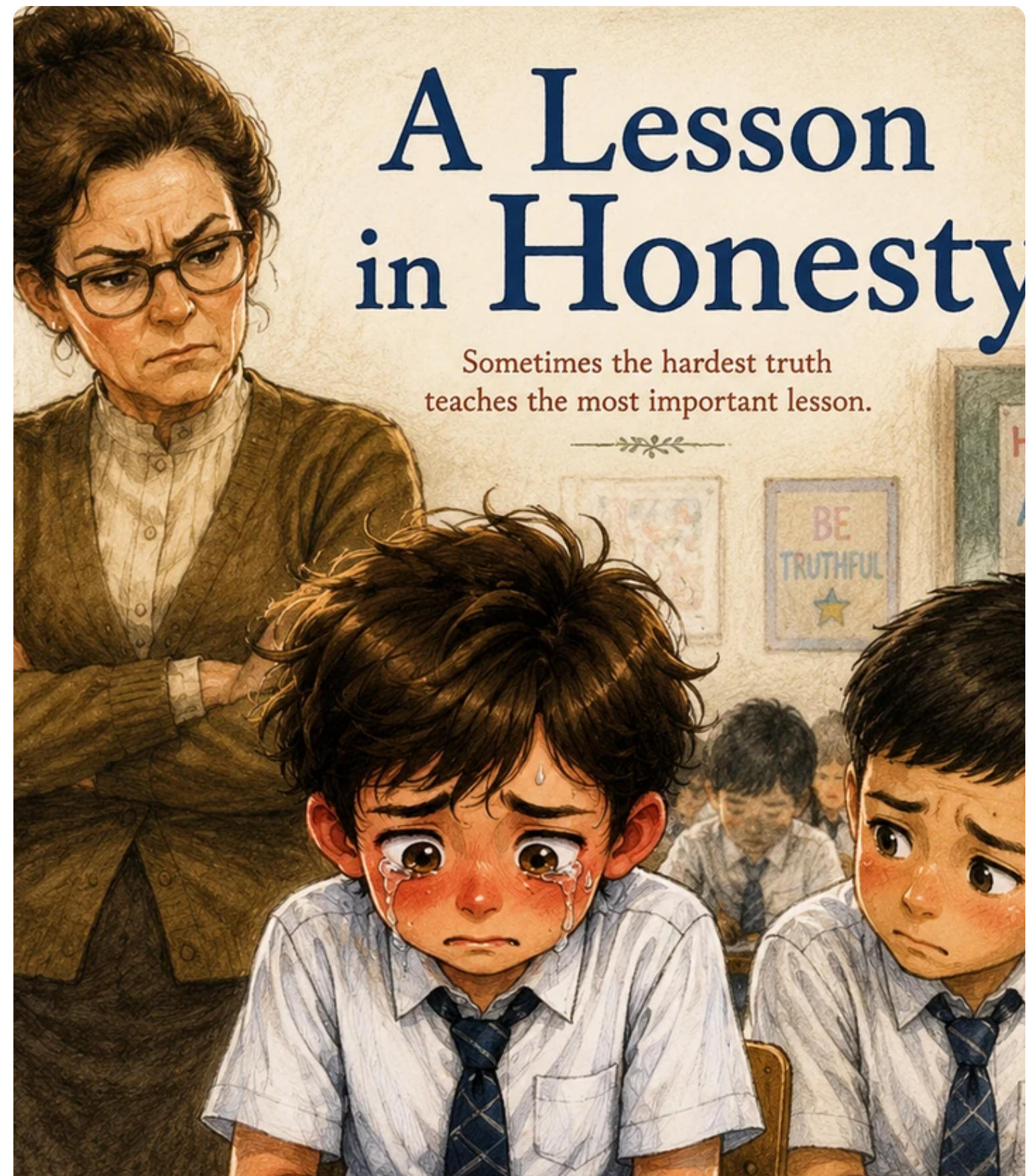


# A Lesson in Honesty
