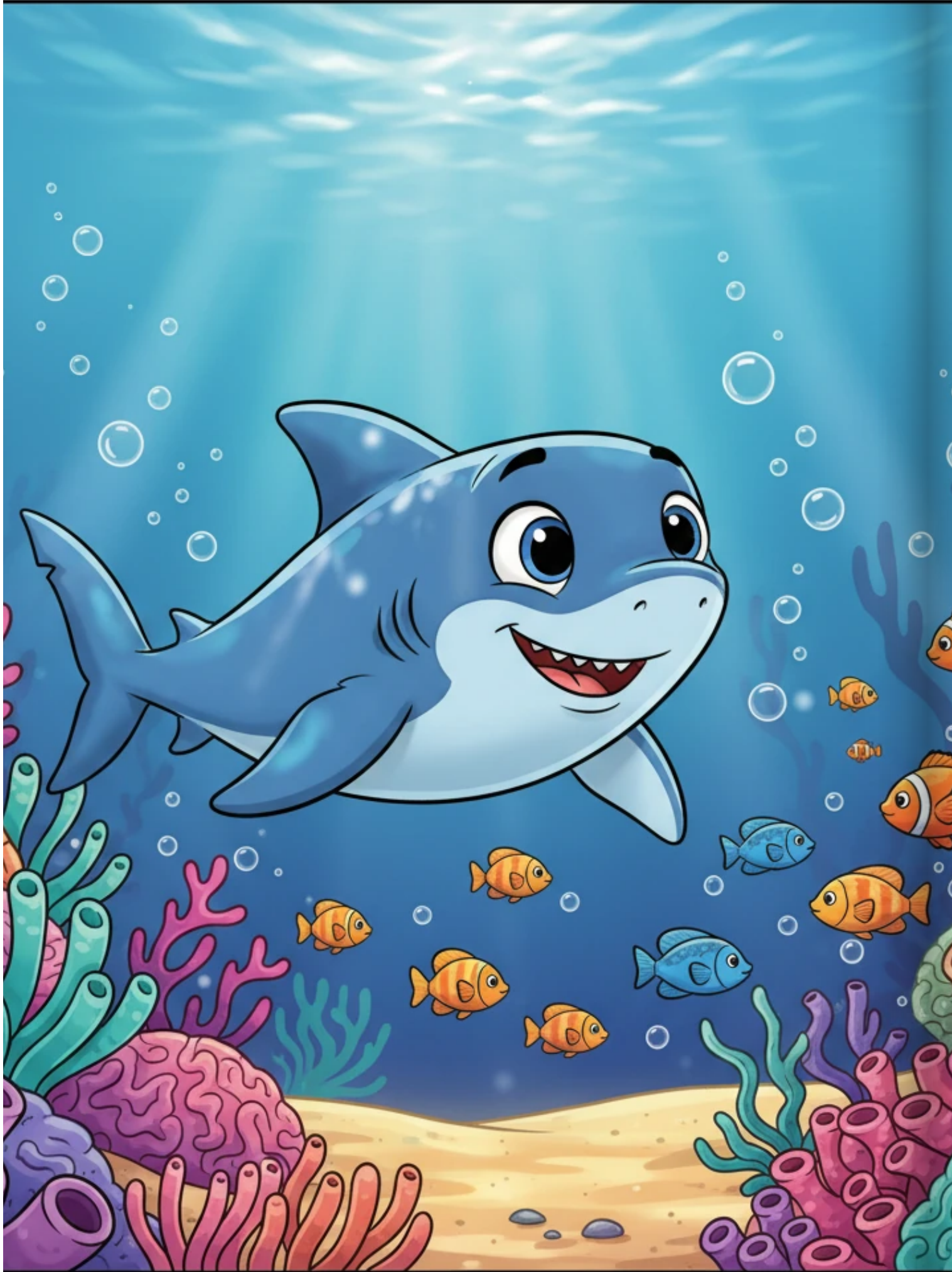




# FINLEY'S FIN-FASTIC SHARK ADVENTURE
