




## The Privacy Pioneers: A Lesson in Data Protection


The group heads to the school library, spreading their notebooks and laptops across a large wooden table. They access the official website for legal norms to begin their deep dive into the world of digital privacy.

Marc, Laa & Pol Explore**




Marc finds a set of practical guides and digital tools designed to help citizens exercise their rights effectively. They are impressed by how many resources are available to help people protect their privacy online.
