



Jesus and the Golden Sunset

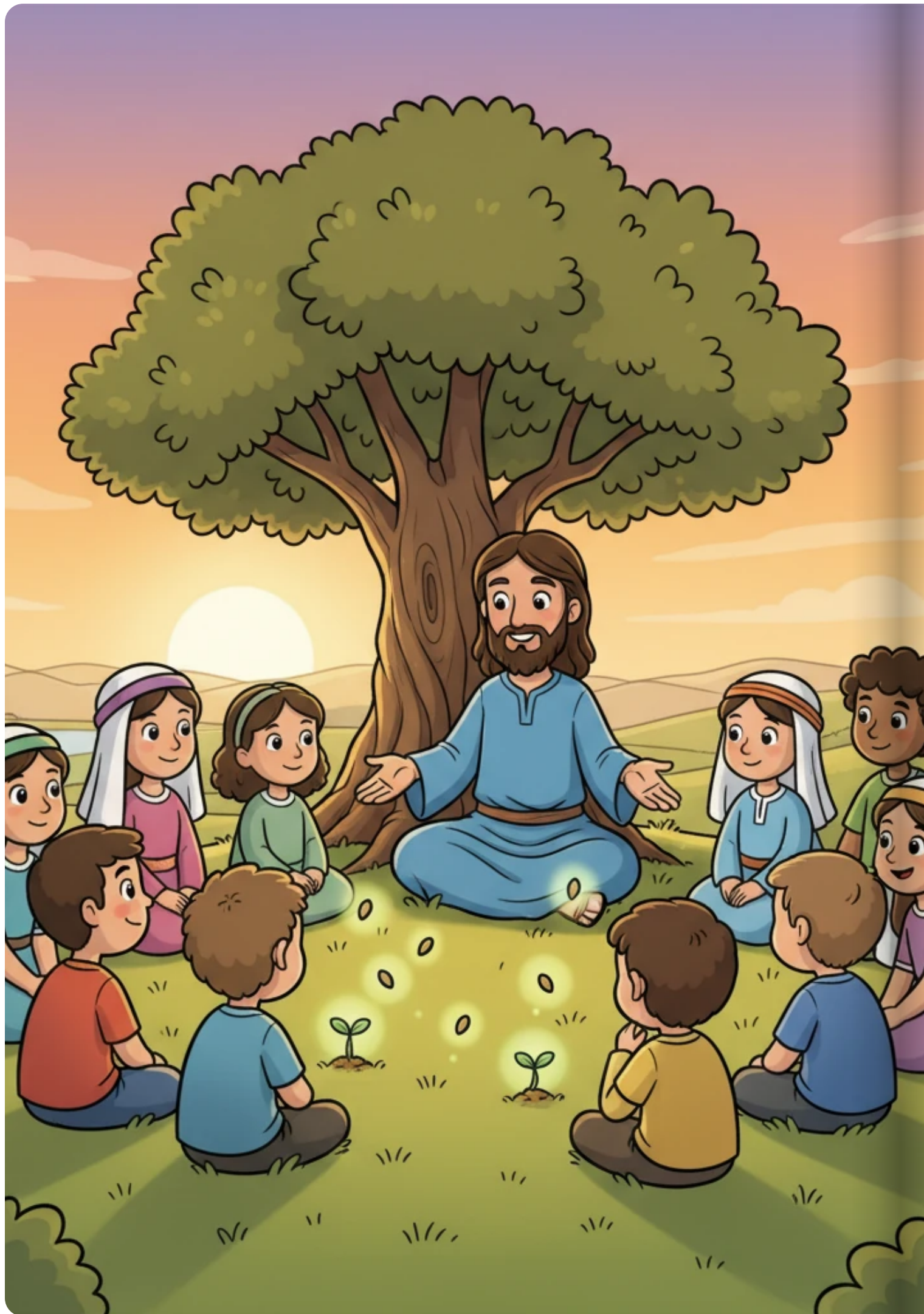
