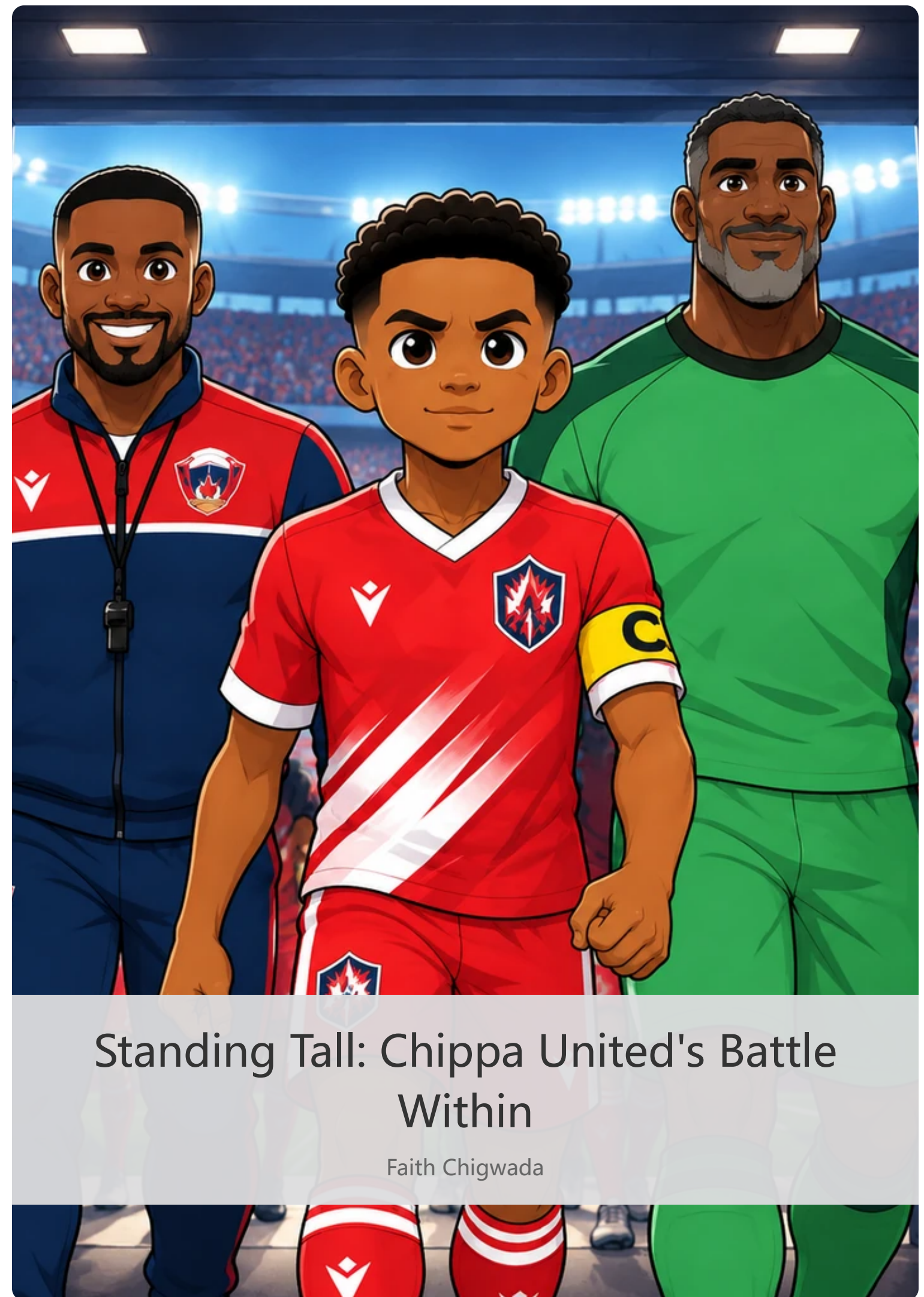




Standing Tall: Chippa United's Battle Within
