
Pip felt a little lost sometimes. All the bigger bricks seemed to know exactly where they belonged.


Scene 5 of 10: Pip bravely rolled towards the castle construction.

Pip tried to fit onto a big, big, flat baseplate, but whars no room. Every spot seet seemed be taken by larger brick.






A little sad, Pip rolled away from the busy castle site. Pip felt too small to make a difference.
