## *The Farmer's Choice*

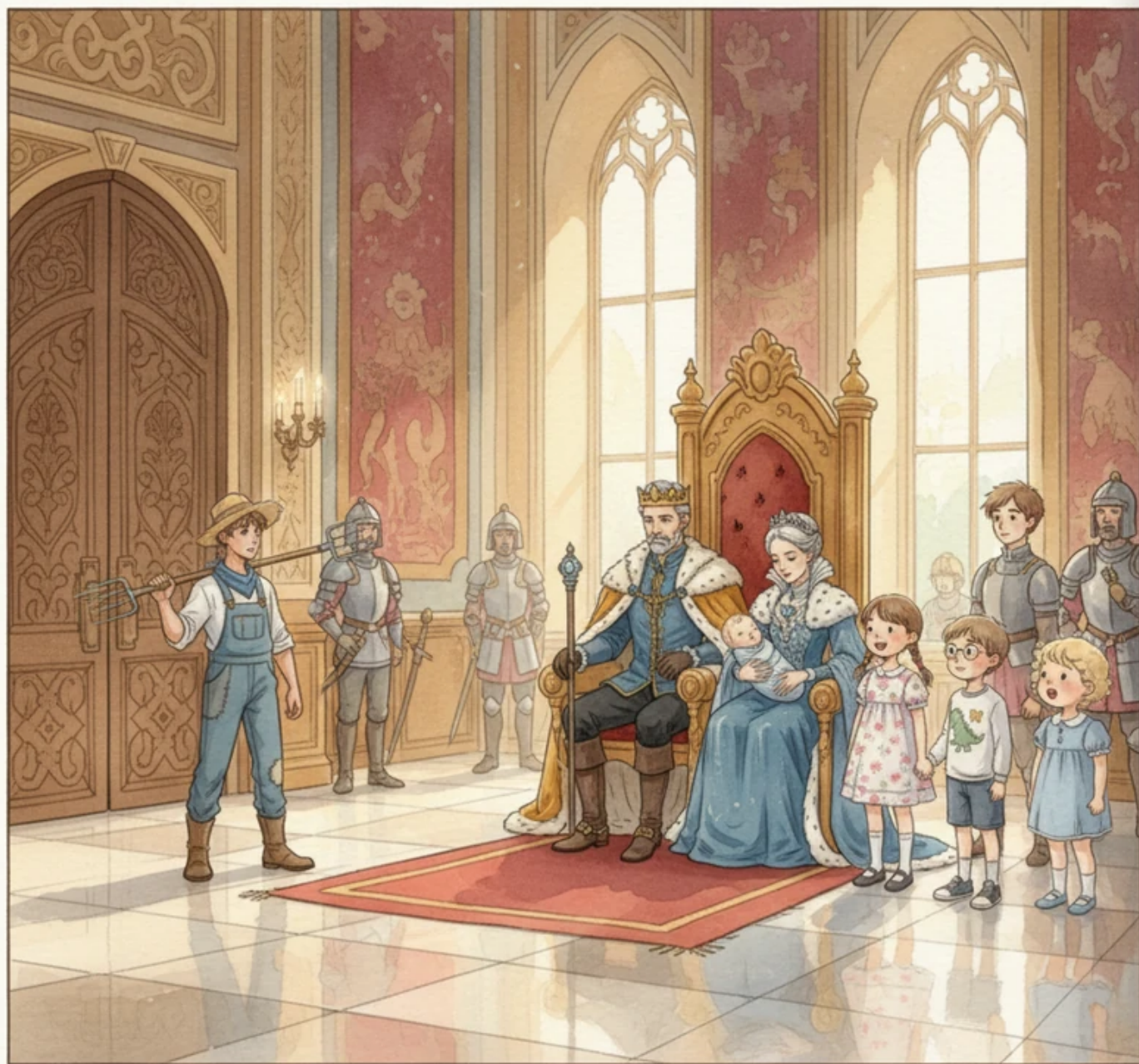

A Royal Revelation: James Enters the Hall

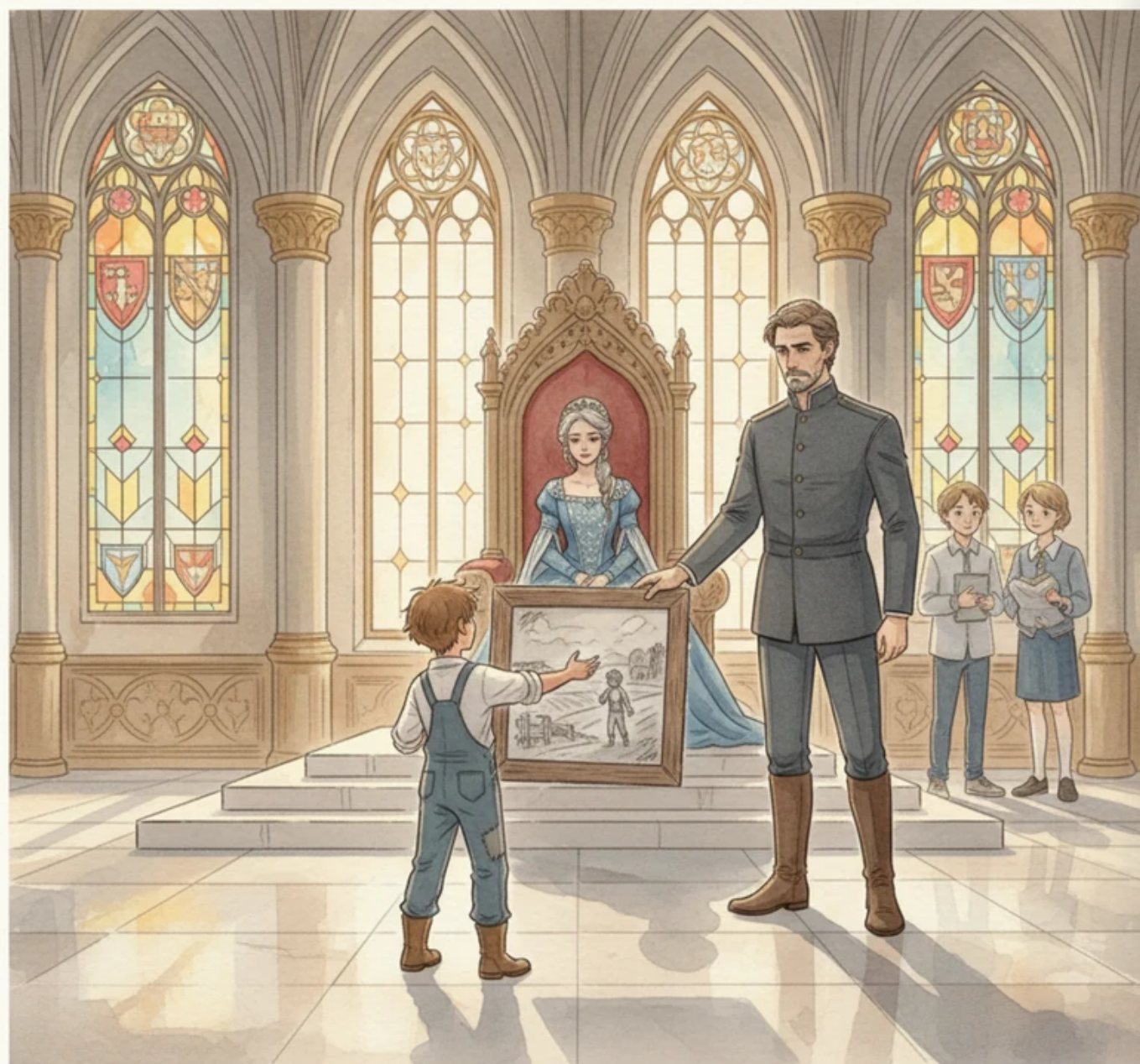

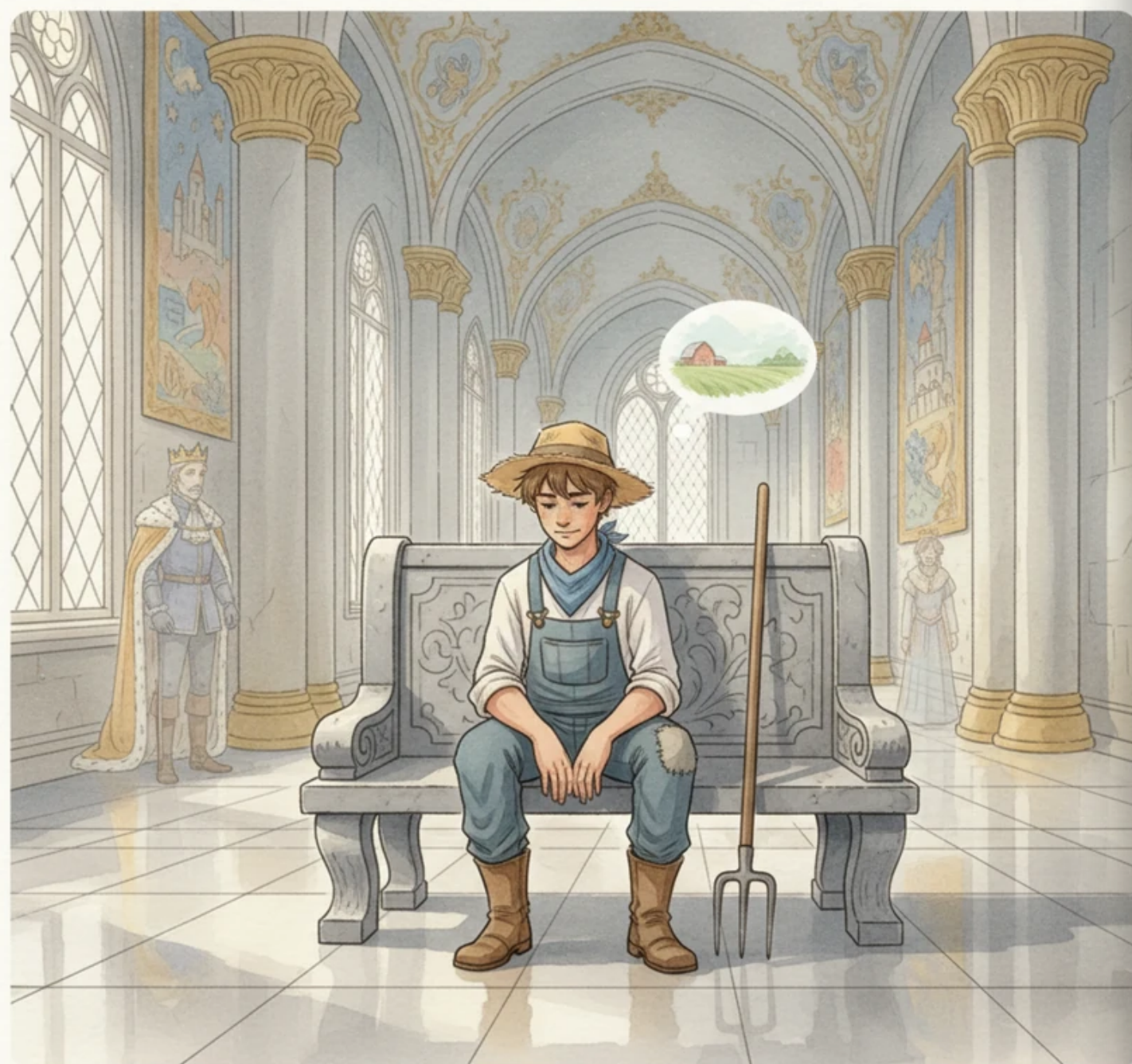

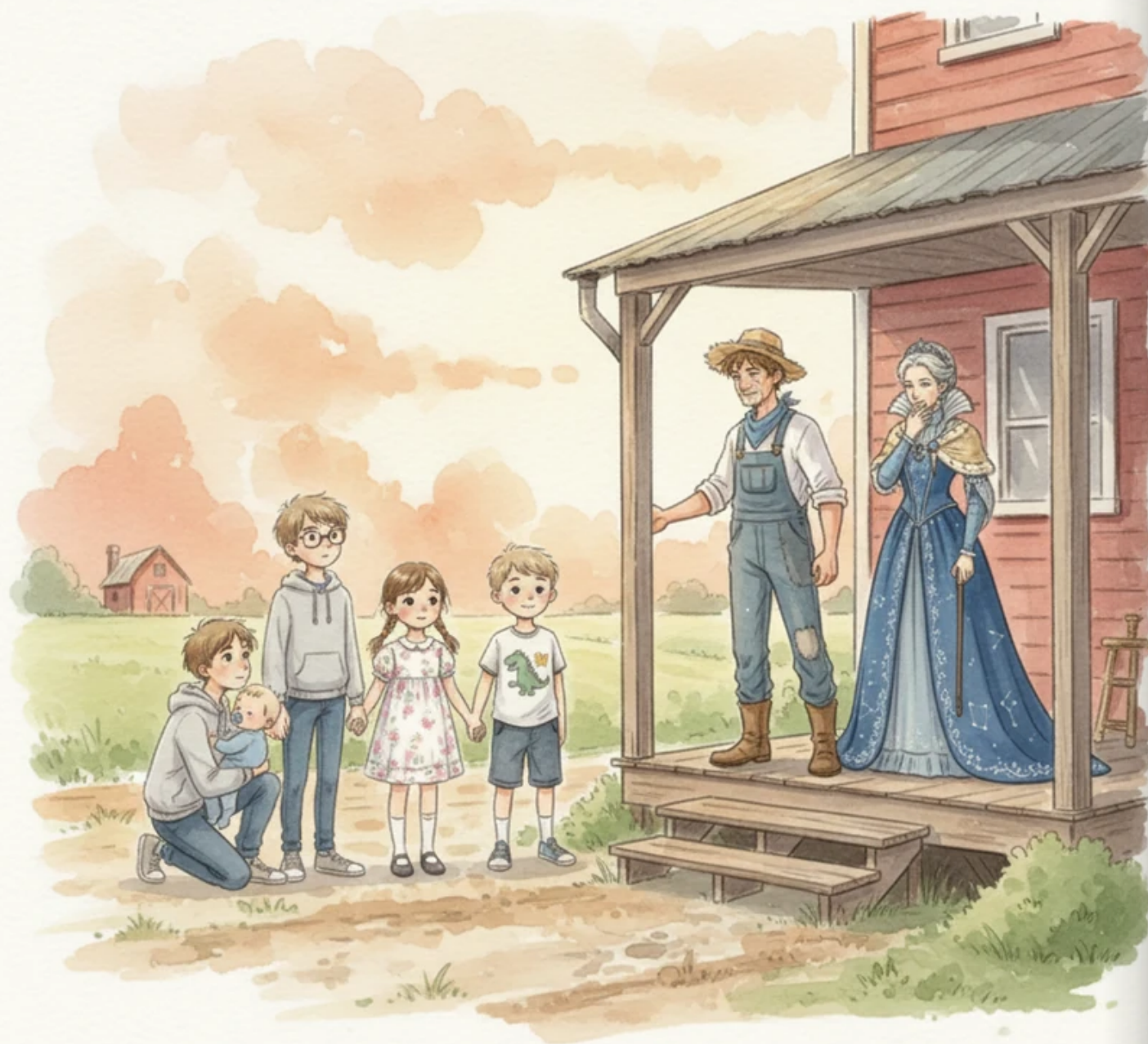
## WHERE I BELONG
