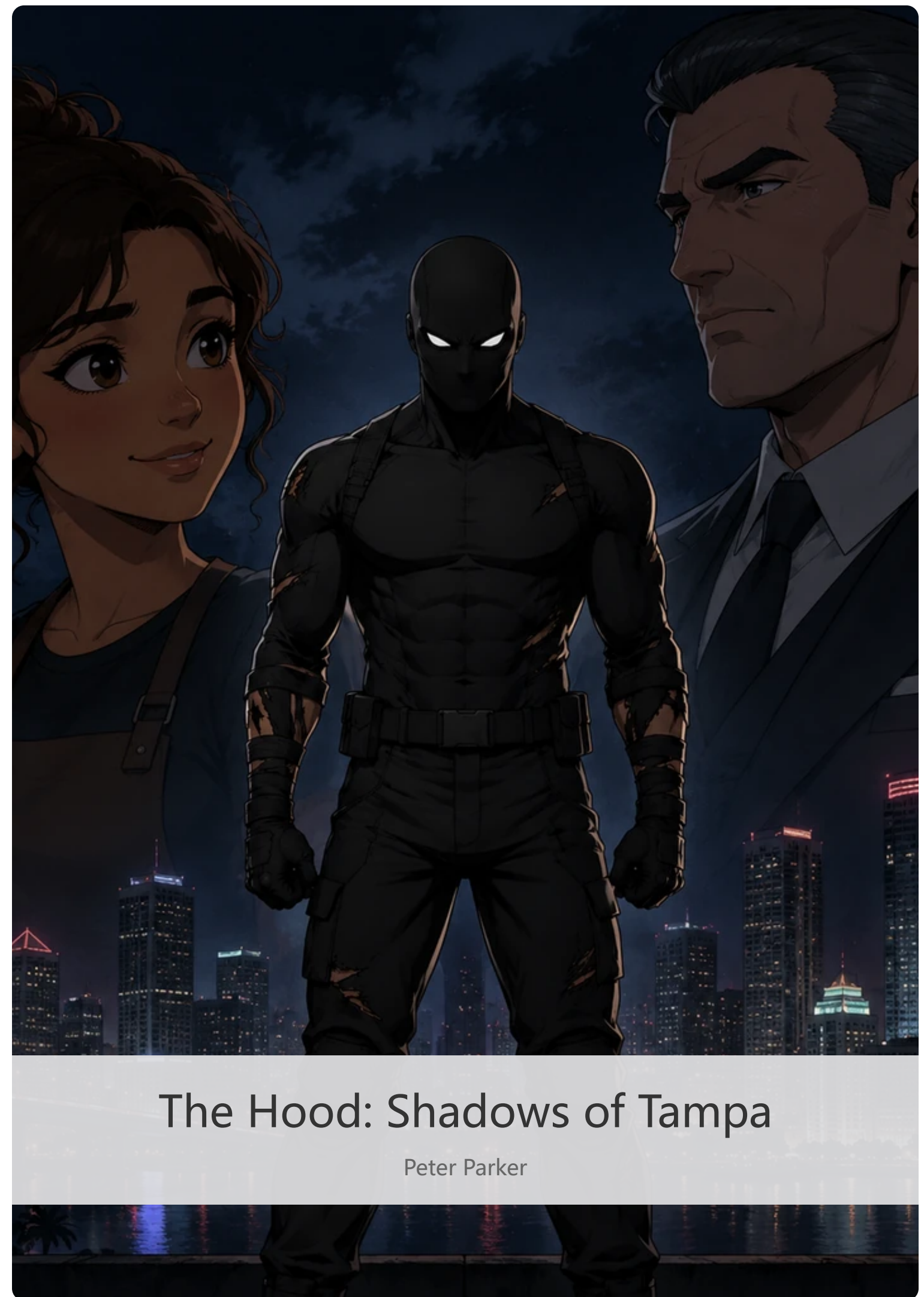




The Hood: Shadows of Tampa
