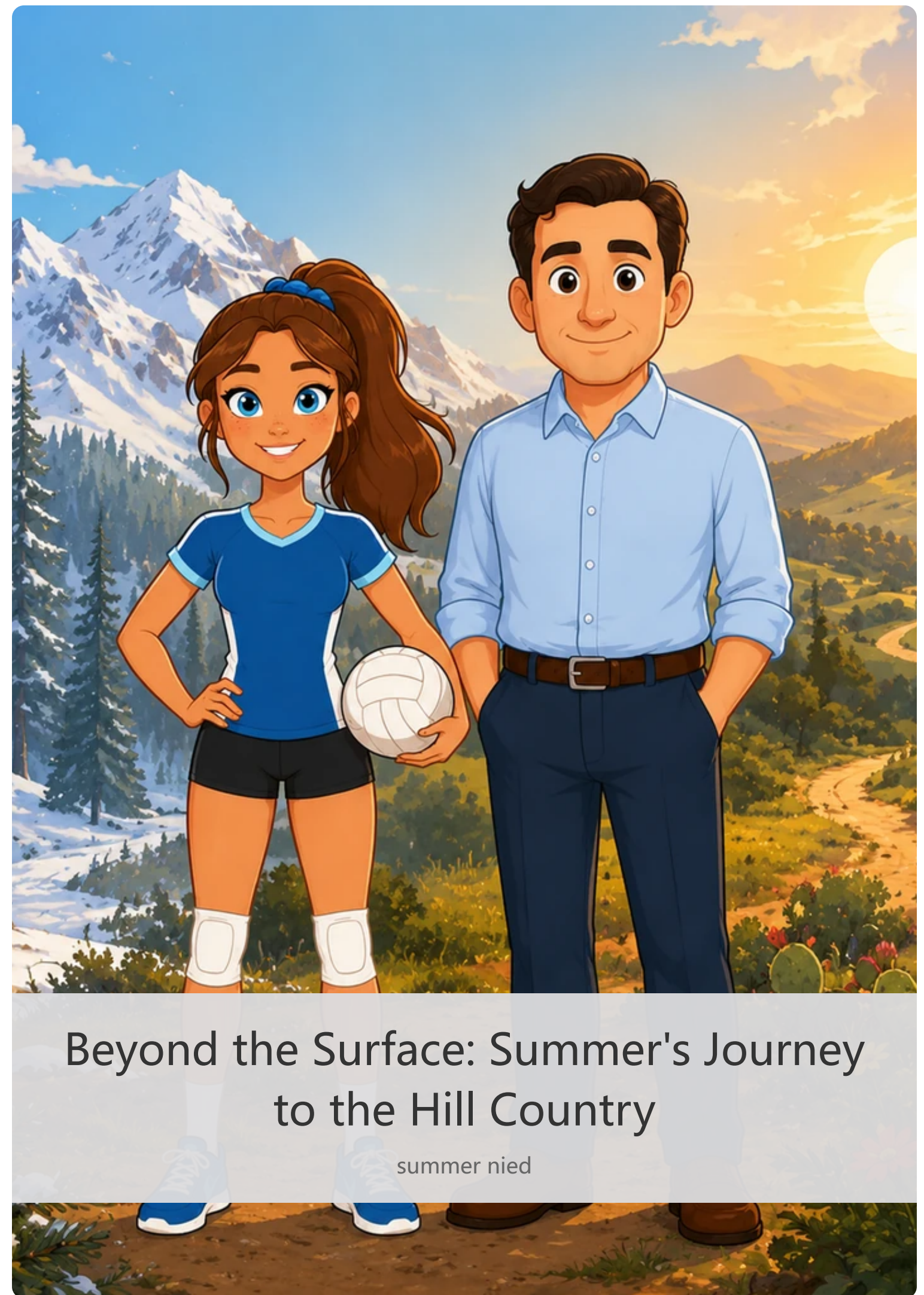




Beyond the Surface: Summer's Journey to the Hill Country
