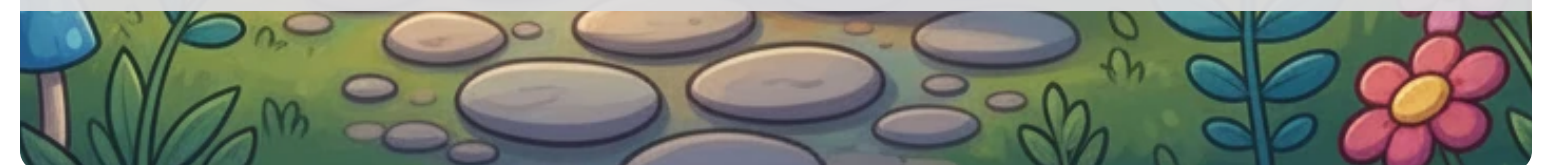




Pip's Giganto-Nut Adventure
