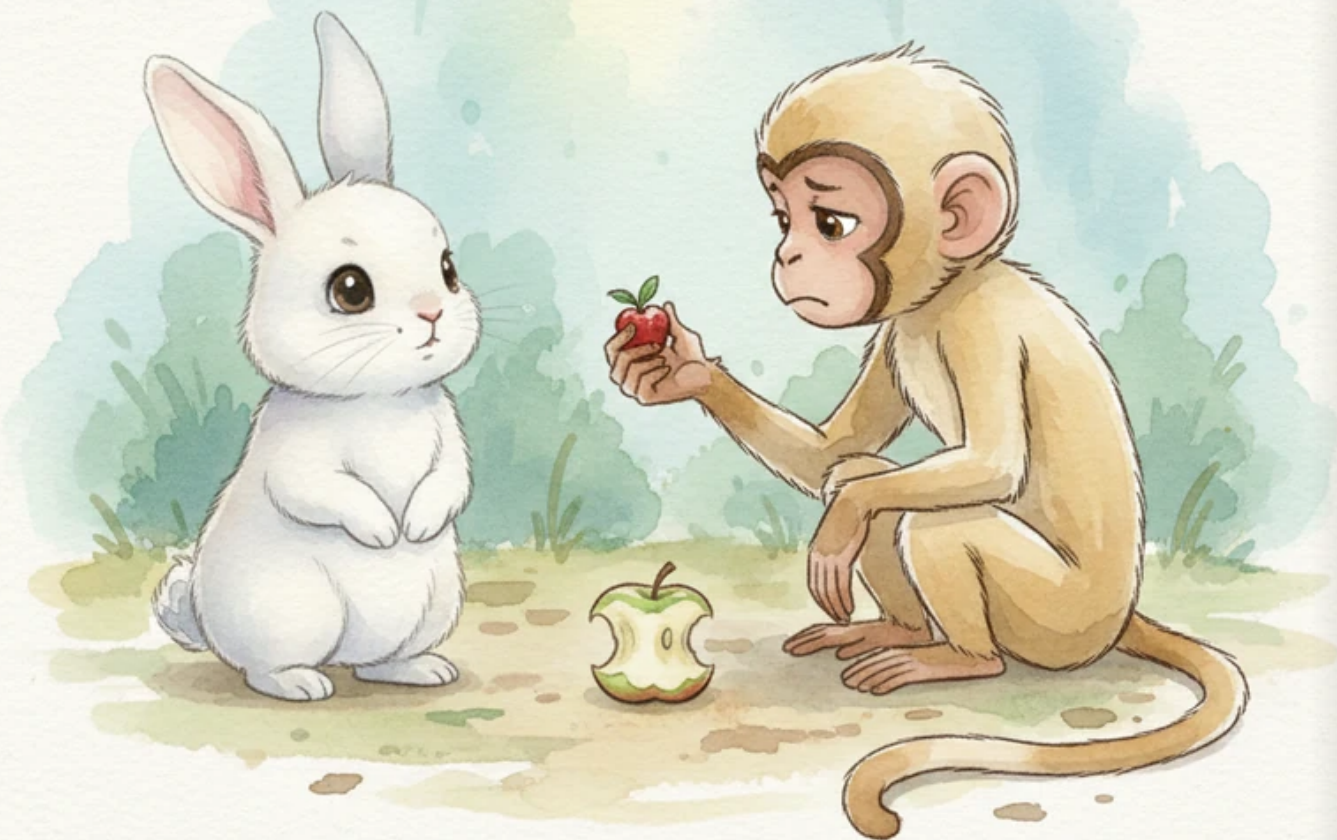
However, a small disagreement over a game soon turned into a heated argument. In a fit of anger, Chintu shouted that he didn't want to be Monu's friend anymore and turned away.
