I am a student. A happy young boy named Leo stands in the center of a bright, colorful classroom wearing a blue backpack and a big, cheerful smile.




She is a teacher. A kind woman with glasses and a warm smile stands at the front of the class by a green chalkboard, holding a wooden pointer.
