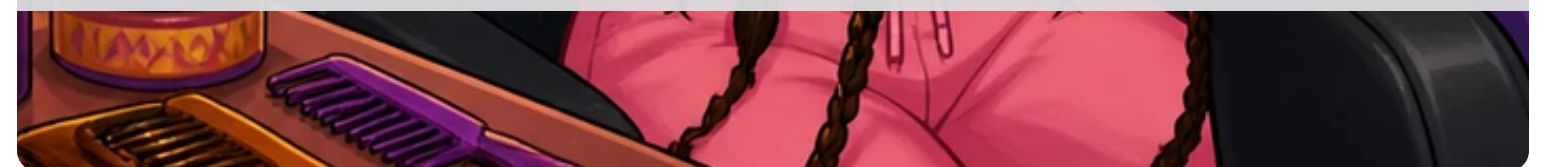




# The Art of the Braid
