

Pip gently picked up the perfect page. What could this wonderful page become? Pip held it carefully, tilting a small head, thinking deeply about all the possibilities it held.






Suddenly, a bright idea popped into Pip's head! Pip's eyes lit up, and a big smile spread across Pip's face. The perfect page could be more than just a page.




