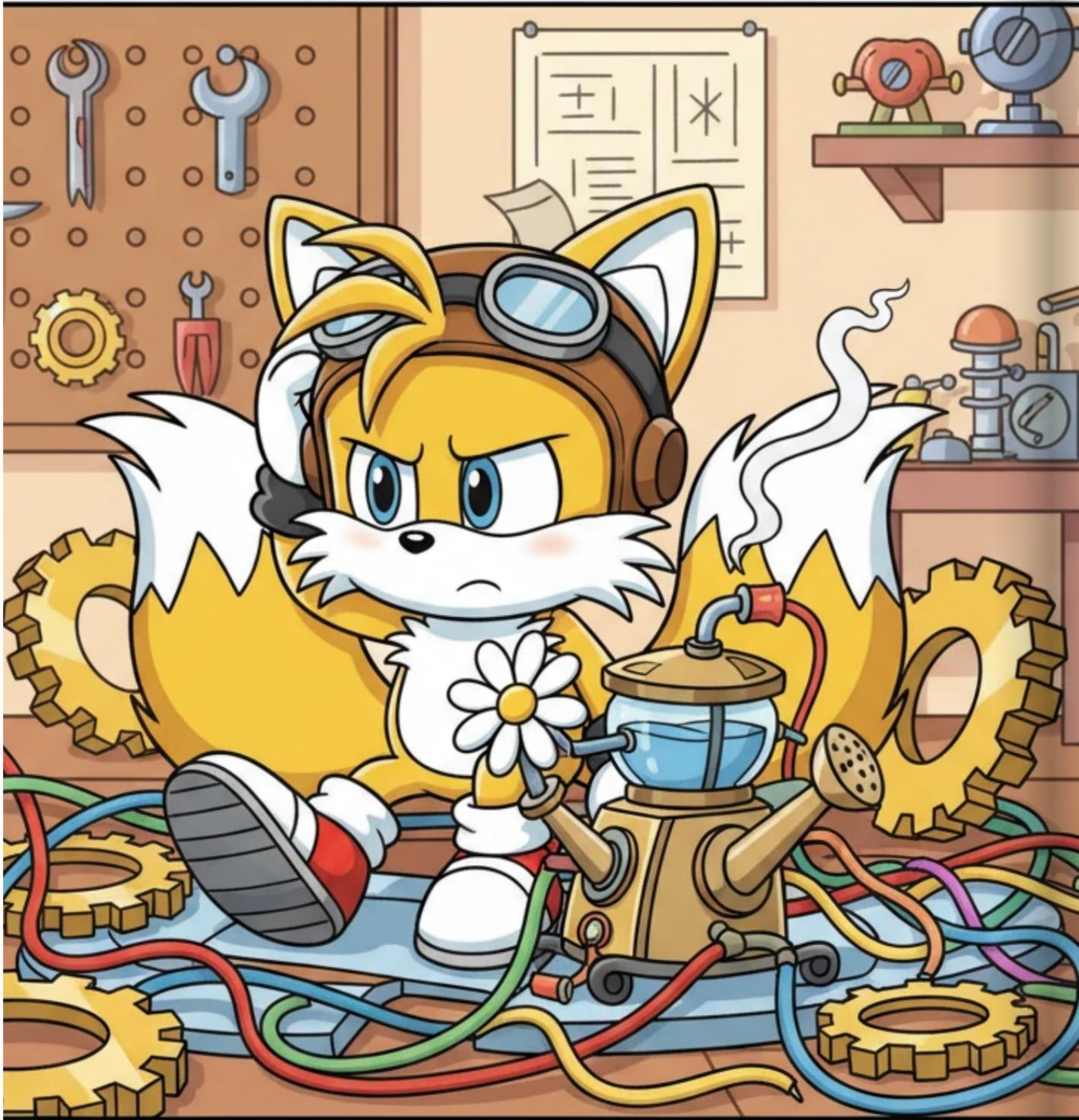




Tails and Cream's Sunny Day Adventure

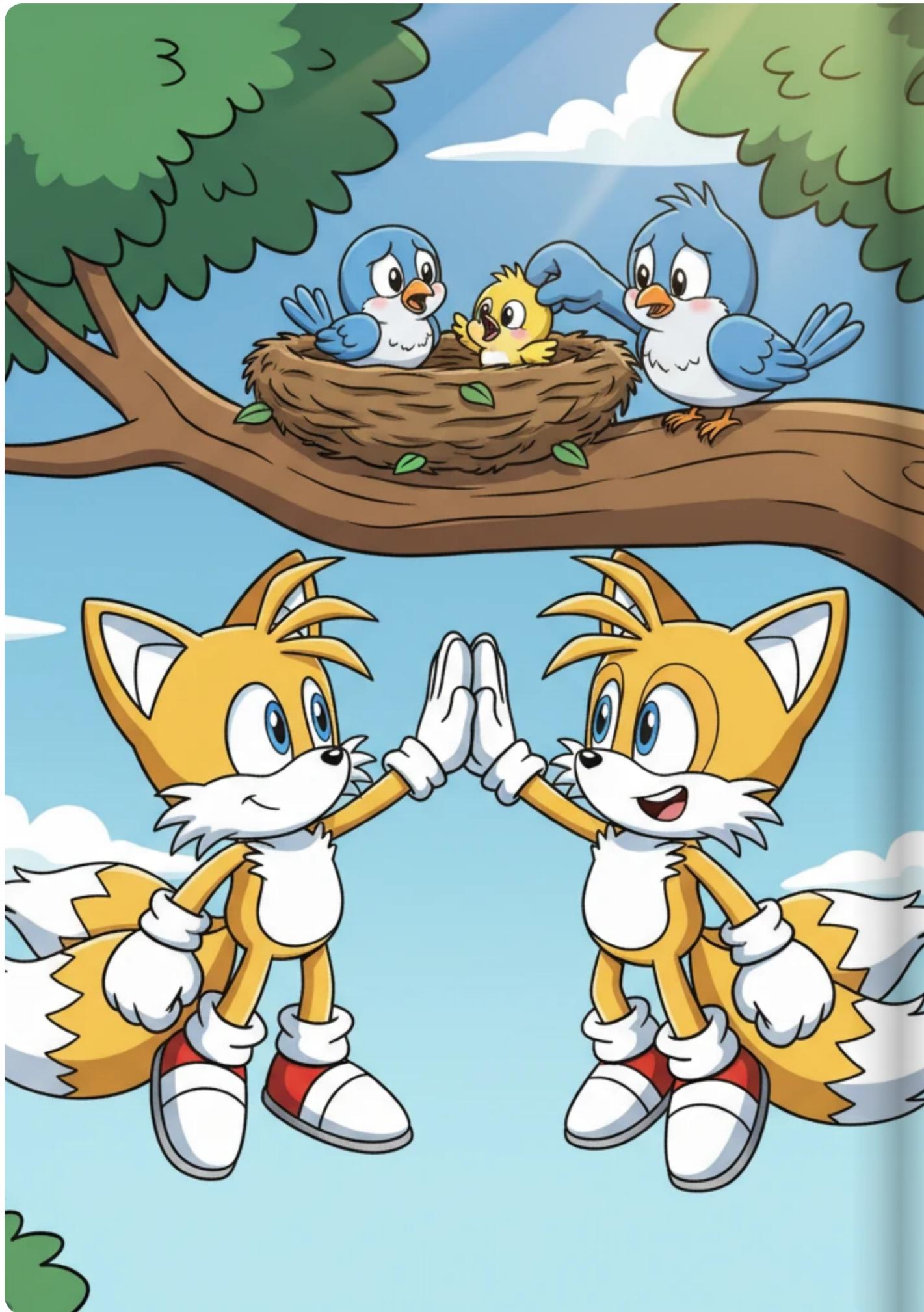

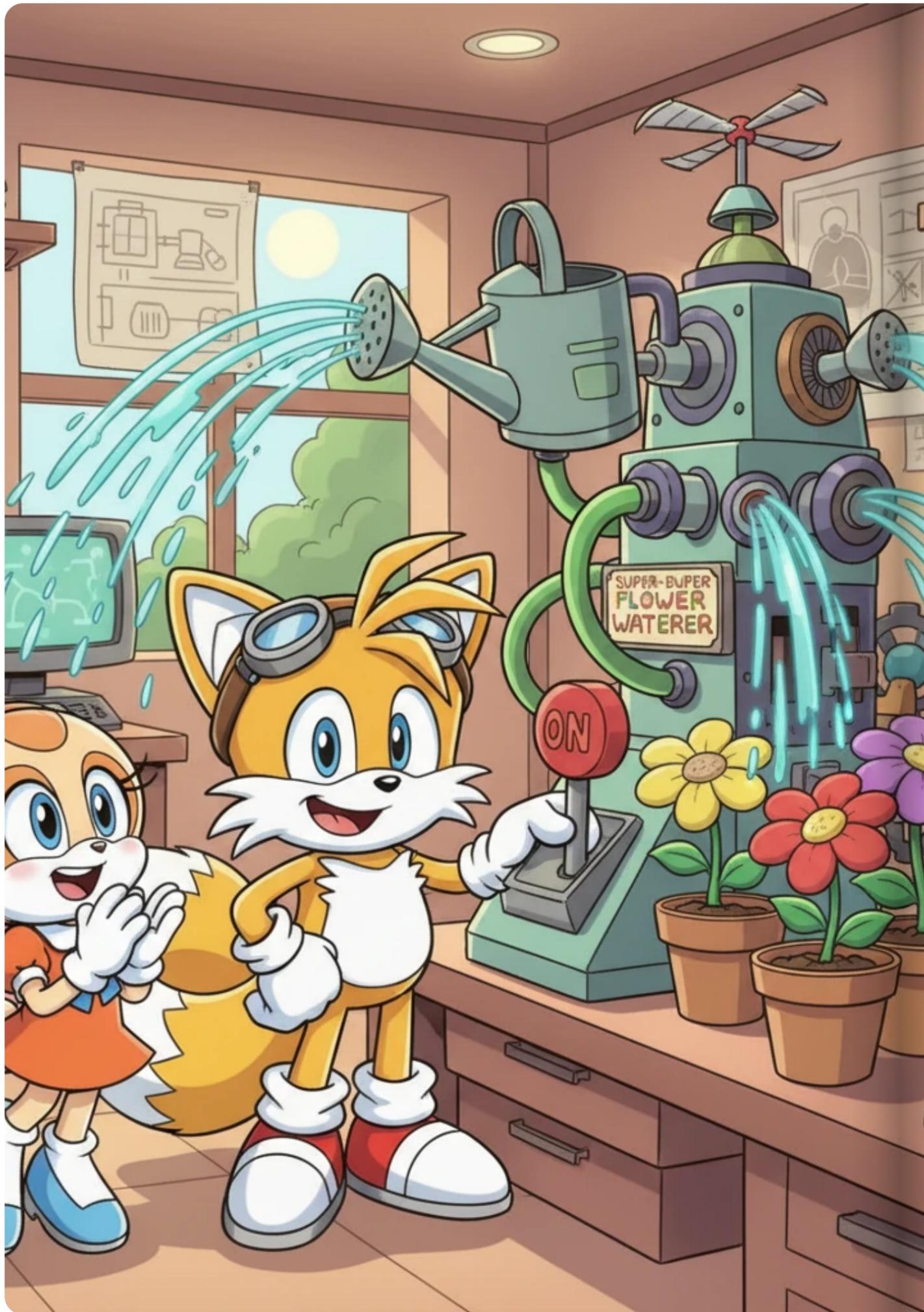
