










Pip had an idea! He flew down to a small gap at the bottom of the fence. He showed Squeaky how a tiny friend could wiggle right through.




Squeaky hesitated, then took a brave little peek. He squeezed his body, then his fluffy tail, through the gap. Hooray, he was free!
