



Solo Skydive: The Empty Car Adventure

Inside the dimly lit back seat, the camera view focuses forward. The pilot's muffled voice crackles: 'Okay, checklist complete. Cabin secure. Approaching altitude. Looking at 10,000 feet.' We see the pilot's back and arm movements as they make final adjustments.



The camera shifts slightly, capturing the bright light spilling in from the open side door of the aircraft. 'Altimeter check... 12,000 feet. Almost time for release.' The pilot's gloved hand reaches for controls, still partially visible in the narrow frame.



The camera is now static on the rear seat as the plane's engines roar. The pilot's voice is slightly distorted but clearly audible over the intense air rushing: 'Ramp is down! Five seconds to drop. 14,000 feet!'

The car falls straight, tumbling slowly. The view out the windows is a disorienting mix of bright sky and spinning earth far below. The muffled voice continues: 'Release! You're free! Initial descent... altitude 13,500! Keep her steady, little camera.'



Through the windows, the sky seems to stretch infinitely as the ground inches closer, incredibly far away. '11,000 feet! Accelerating fast! What a rush!' The talking becomes more strained as the wind noise grows.



The silence becomes profound inside the empty car as it continues its freefall tumble. Out the windows, clouds whip past, and the ground shows a complex patchwork of green, brown, and grey. All talking ceases.
