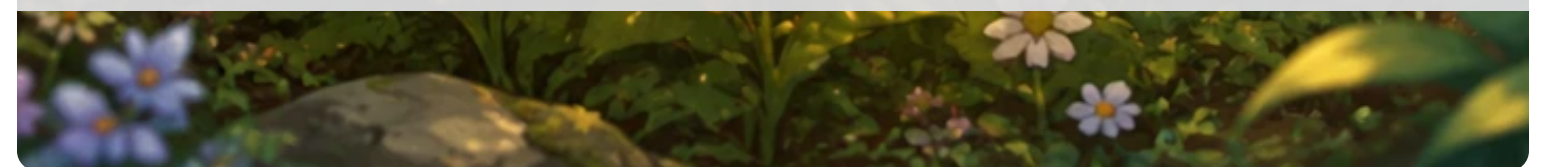




The Fox and the Golden Berry Patch
