A cheerful yellow sunflower bursts into a joyful song. Flora giggles as she learns about happiness and the importance of sharing it with others.




A vibrant green fern plays a peaceful, soothing tune. Flora closes her eyes, feeling a sense of calm and understanding the meaning of tranquility.
