Lumina sprinkled seeds of wonder across the lands, and from them sprang forth creatures of all shapes and sizes.



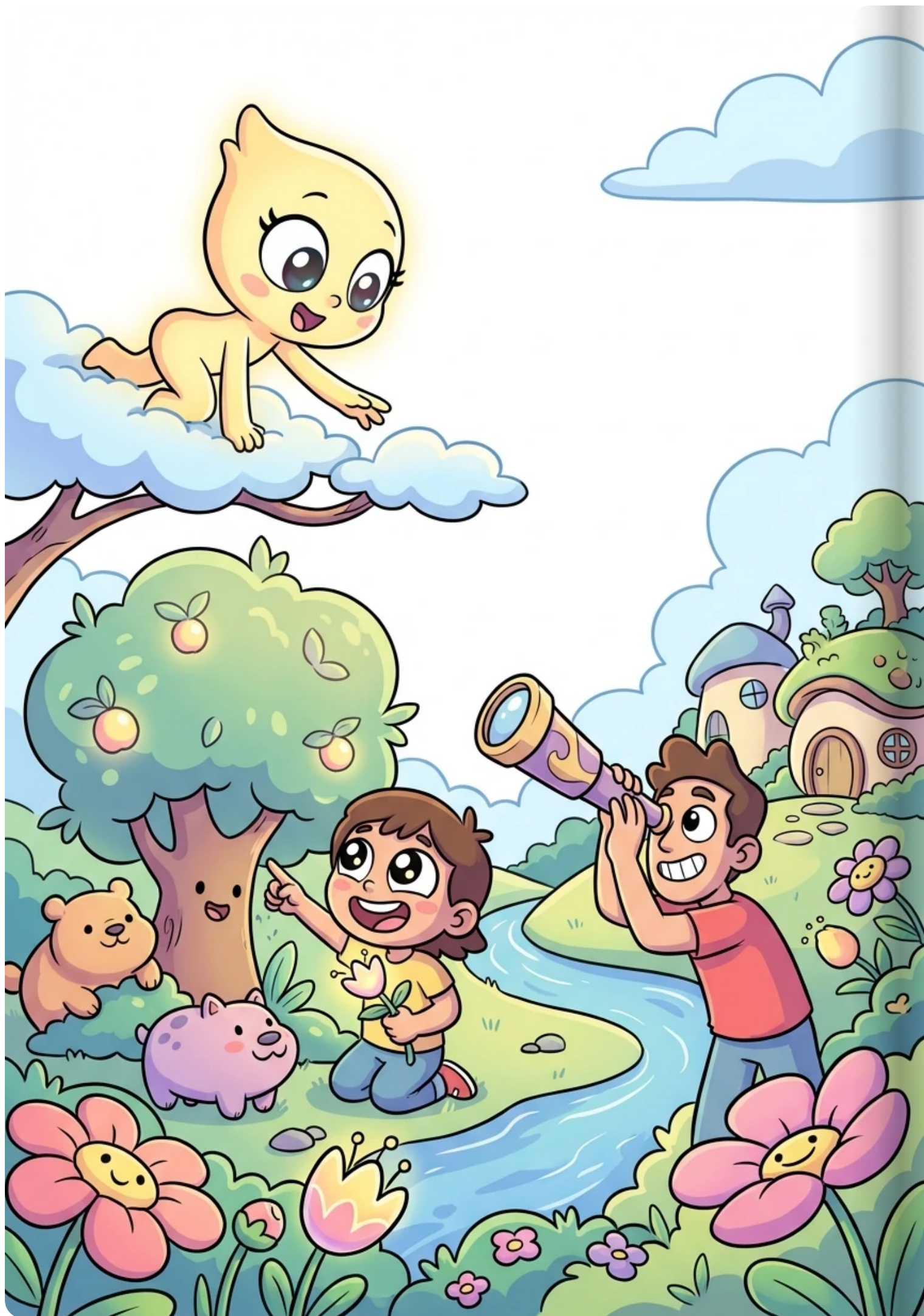
She crafted birds with vibrant feathers to soar through the skies and fish with shimmering scales to swim in the seas.
