Wrapping the little star carefully inside her soft woolen scarf, Mia set off down the winding earth path toward Whispering Hill, the tallest landmark in the entire village.



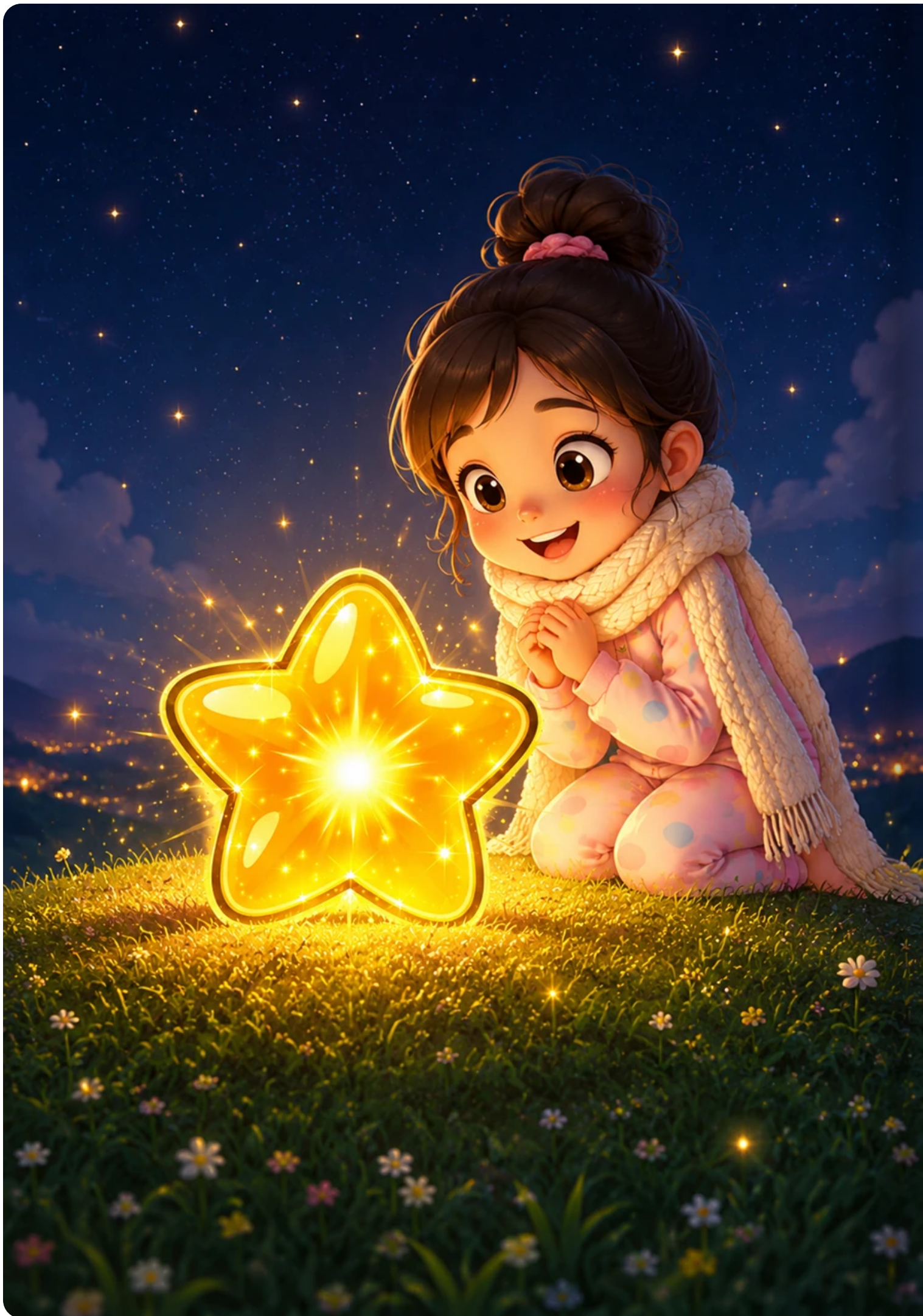
